called black bird, I also will & appoint that all my moveable estate be
sold public sale except what I have mentioned & that the money & money as above
I will unto my Nephew William Mathew a good horse & half of its value
be taken out of all the other shares above mentioned; I also Will & appoint
Joseph Fairies & Nathan Griffith Executors of this my last will & Testament -
