That my funeral Expenses with all my lawful & just Debts shall be paid, and if it may hereafter appear on good evidence to my Executors that in the course of my dealing or business I have palpably wronged or imposed on any Person they are hereby directed to make full & ample Restitution, and as to the remainder of my Estate It is my Will that it should be sold to the best advantage under the direction of my Executors & the proceeds of those sales divided into three equal parts one of which third parts I give & bequeath unto my Brother John Hill of the County Derry in the Kingdom of Ireland to him his Heirs & assigns forever — the other third part thereof I give & bequeath unto my Sister Margaret Reed also of the County of Derry & Kingdom of Ireland to her, her Heirs, & assigns forever — And as to the remaining third part I bequeath for the purpose of Educating & instructing Poor & promising Youth to be disposed of & parcelled out for that end under the Choice & disposition of the Reverend the Moderator & Presbytery of Orange in the State of North Carolina. — And I do hereby constitute & appoint as Executors of this my last Will & Testament the Reverend Robert Archibald of Wakeham County & Mr David Manely of Rowan County both in the State of N^c Carolina. And do at the same time utterly revoke & disannul all former Wills, Testaments & Executors by me in any wise made or appointed, Constituting this to be my last Will & Testament.
