coat, The rest of my estate to be sold & equally divided among
my wife & children my son Joseph excepted, I do make & appoint
my trusty friend Anne Williams & Charles Williams Executors of
this my last will, and I do hereby revoke, disannul, & make
void all other wills, made by me & before acknowledge this to be my
last will & testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand & seal this 8th day of January 1778.

personal Estate. Item I give & bequeath unto Samuel Norton

I now live to him his Heirs & assigns forever at Captain his next
death, provided that he the said Samuel Norton pay to my Execr's
the sum of Fifty pounds per ann: money for the use of my other legatees
Item. I give & bequeath unto James Norton my third son the sum of five pounds.
Item I give & bequeath unto Margaret Whaley my oldest daughter the sum of
Ten pounds for the use & behoof of her daughter Susannah. Item I give
Whaleys the sum to Susannah & Capt my second daughter the sum of
Ten pounds. Item I give & bequeath unto Agnes Houston the sum of
Ten pounds. It is further my will & pleasure that after my just debts
& these above mentioned legacies are paid that all the remainder
of my Estate be equally divided among my children. -
And I do hereby constitute & appoint Agnes & the aforesd James
Norton to be my executors of this my last will & Testament to
