39 In the name of God Amen. I Robert Harrison son of the late
of S^c Carolina Mecklenburg County, calling to mind the Mortality
of my body, that it is appointed for all men once to die, & being
in perfect mind & memory, do constitute & make this my last
will & testament, and first of all I do will my body to be
buried out of my estate—2^d I do will that all my last debts
shall be paid by my Executors 3^d I do will to my dearly be-
loved wife Sarah Harrison her living off this plantation dur-
ing her widowhood, likewise the Chest of drawers & two beds
well furnished with Cloaths & a stand of Curtains, likewise
my two horses & two cows, 4th I do will to my son William
Harrison the plantation where he first settled 5th I do will
to my son James Harrison the three hundred dollars that he
received from me to pay the plantation he now lives on, 6th I do
will to my sons John & Robert Harrison the plantation I
purchased from James Harrison to be equally divided
between them 7th I do will to my son Thomas Harrison
the plantation on which I now live & likewise the Bay mare
& Colt & the two Cows & Calves which I left him with their
increase & likewise all the hogs. 8th I will that the land on the
Western Meads shall be divided in the following man-
ner that seven hundred & fifty acres shall be equally divided
between my four sons, John, James, Robert & Thomas Harrison
& two hundred & fifty acres to my son William Harrison
9th As that what I have left my son Thomas Harrison is not

sufficient for to compensate him for the time that he has staid
 with the trouble that he may have with his mother & me I do will
 that he shall have a set of farming tools Equal to those that the
 rest of my sons receive from me; further I do will that my son
 Thomas Morrison shall have my negro Luke at the death of my
 mother with his increase. 10th I do will to my daughter Martha
 an equal share of my moveable property with those of my
 daughters that has left me; I do will that Martha shall have
 a bed with furnished at the death of her mother for the time
 she has staid & the trouble that she has had with her mother & me,
 I do also will that Martha is to have one bush of Land
 yearly for Cotton while she stays I do also impose on my
 Executors to reserve her as they may think proper for the time
 she may lose & the trouble she may have with her mother & me
 11th I do will to my daughter Edige both the Chest of drawers
 at the death of her mother. 12th I do will to my daughter Sally
 Bradshaw one bush at the death of her mother for working
 longer with me than some of the rest of my daughters; 13th I do
 will to my son in law Daniel Caldwell five Dollars and an
 Equal share of my goods with the rest of my children. 14th I do
 will that my books shall be Equally divided among all my
 children. 15th I do will that my Legatee shall have power
 to choose men to praise my negro & am that he is to have liber-
 ty to choose his master. If he should die so soon that he could
 do much advantage towards the maintenance of my wife
 my daughter shall no demand against any of my sons for
 any part but if he should die near the death of my wife they
 are to receive fifty dollars from each of my sons. 16th I do will
 that my son Thomas shall have all the property that he has
 purchased or made since I committed the care of my property
 to him. 17th I do will that Martha also shall have all the property that
 she has purchased or made since she was twenty five years of age.
 18th I do will that all my moveable property after the death of Martha is
 received in time & should with their mother shall be put to
 public sale (Negro Dave excepted) & shall be Equally divided among
 the children & the house of Green David included.

Thomas Harrison shall have my negro Jude at the death of me
 matter with her increase. 10th I do will to my daughter Martha
 my equal share of my moveable property with those of my
 daughters that has left me, I do will that Martha shall have
 a bed well furnished at the death of her mother for the time
 she has lived & the trouble that she has had with her mother & me,
 I do also will that Martha is to have one lute of Sarah
 Gandy for 'tation while she stays I do also impose on my
 Executors to reward her as they may think proper for the time
 she may live & the trouble she may have with her mother & me
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 -ty to choose his master & if he should die so soon that he cannot
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 to him 17th I do will that Martha also shall have all the property that
 she has purchased or made since she was twenty five years of age
 18th I do will that all my moveable property after the death of
 my wife & trouble with them mother shall be put to
 public sale (Negro Dams excepted) & shall be equally divided among
 all my daughters the price of negro Dams included -
 I do hereby revoke & disannul all other Wills & Testaments &
 do acknowledge this to be my last Will & Testament given under my
 my hand this 1st day of April I do Appoint my sons William & John &
 John & the Hon. Esquire my Executors Robert Harrison
