29 The testimony of God Linn, March 26th 1800. I declare whereof that
I am of Holiness & Integrity of life & behavior, being very low in body, bent of
perfect mind & memory, & am bedridden, and declining to mind the mortality
of the body and that it appeared so all men once to die. Do make
this my last will & testament, and that it may stand & last till death, and
in the place and land I hold from time to this life, I now desire & give in this
way & manner, it is, that is today it is my will that my wife
Sarah have the land & all other property under her care during
our natural life, and thence to sever in the way last but that she
may have, & part, the same, released by these subaddings to her I give
her, James Patten & James Curry & a sum of money of the sum
aforesaid in the County Court. That my wife Sarah shall be
