State of N.C. herein being in a low State of bodily health best of pre-
dict mind & memory yet knowing the uncertainty of human life &
that it is appointed unto all men to die I consider it a duty when
I come to my great locator & my surviving friends to make such dis-
tribution of the worldly goods which God has blessed me with
as seems most just & equitable according to circumstances I do
therefore make the following distribution. Item I bequeath
my Soul the better part to God who gave it, and my body to be
so early interred at my decease in such place as shall seem most
proper to my executors in hopes of a joyfull resurrection thro' the
mercy of the great Redeemer. Item I desire that all my just debts
be fully paid out of the sum total of my moveable property before any
distribution be made. Item I bequeath all my lands & the benefit
arising therefrom to my wife and wife Eleanor during our
natural life, & her slaves to become the property of William H. Marshall
junior of this County. Also all the remainder of my moveable pro-
perty after my debts are paid to be at the sole disposal of my son
Eleanor — Item I do appoint my wife wife Eleanor and
William H. Marshall executors of this my last will & testament
Lastly I do declare this to be my last will & testament made this
29th day of March 1793 witness my hand & seal in presence
of William Harrison

dispossession of the same as follows — First I will that my just debts and
