

To make this my last will & Testament in manner & form following
to wit First I declare all my lawful debts to be fully discharged
and paid - Then I will & bequeath unto my well beloved wife Jane
the one half of all my estate to her own use & behoof -
Then I also will & bequeath unto my well beloved daughter
Mary the other h. l. f. of my estate to be put to interest till she
comes of age - And for the true Execution of this my last
will & Testament I do choose & appoint my well beloved
brother Newton Pinney to be whole & sole Executor of this
my last will as witness my hand & seal this 19th of July 1793

In the name of God amen. I Robert Phillips
of Rockbridge County State of W^e Virginia, being in health of
body & sound mind & memory (blessed be God) but calling to mind
the mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all men
once to die, Do make this 23^d day of August in the year of our Lord
1793 make & proclaim this my last will & testament in manner &
form following 1793. Th^e witness I give & bequeath my soul into
the hands of almighty God to be givⁿ him, beseeching for a gracious
acceptance thro' the merits of Jesus Christ my Saviour & my
body &灵魂 committed to the earth to be buried in a Christian like &
decent manner at the discretion of my executors hereafter to be
named, unto my worthy goods wherewith it has pleased God to blesse

me worth I dispose of in the following manner -

Item. 1st. what I desire is that after my decease all my just debts
be paid out of my estate by my executors herein named -
Item 2^d. I give & bequeath to my beloved daughter Jane Phillips (by way of
an annuity) a house & lot, a brother bed & furniture & fifty
part of people arising from the cultivation of the plantation where
I now live, & a house to live in during the time she ch^s to
live on the plantation & my negro girl back together with the best
part of the kitchen & kitchen furniture all sharing her natural life

in State of widowhood. Then I give & bequeath to my son William Phillips
a feather bed & furniture & a horse (either after my death or before) to
belong to him & his Heirs forever. Then I give & bequeath to my daughter
Polly Phillips a horse & saddle a feather bed & furniture, and after the
decease or marriage of my beloved wife my negro girl back & one third
of the kitchen & dairy furniture & two cows & calves to belong to her
& her Heirs forever. Then I give & bequeath to my son Robert Phillips
the plantation whereon I now live with its improvements after my death
he giving his mother the fifth of the profits arising from it clearing
her natural life or widowhood & the two work horses, two pair of
Geese & two Pigeons, tree weeding tools & mallets, &c an Ap., a Saddle
Horse & Saddle, a feather bed & furniture, six cows, & Mares, together
& Cattle & the one half of the crop that may be in the ground or
Harvest at the time of my decease which I allow to support him
self & whatever family I may leave with him, let me my negro man
him, or if I should leave him for less than the one third fraction for
him, the whole of the above & one third of the crops & kitchen
furniture to belong to him & his Heirs forever.

Then I give & bequeath to my son John Phillips the sume never
less proportion & a feather bed, bed to my son George Phillips a feather
bed & three pieces of furniture; and after all the aforesaid legacies
are paid off, then my will & desire is that all my other property
of every nature & kind not in this will mentioned or described, I
allow & desire to be sold at publick sale, & if it amounts to two
hundred pounds then to be equally divided between my two sons
John & George, & if it shoule amount to more, then that I leave
them the sumphes to be equally divided between my daughter
Polly & Robert Phillips the whole as in this divided to belong
to them & their Heirs forever. Will I do hereby nominate & appoint
my beloved wife Dorothy & my son William Phillips
executors of this my last will & testament, & I do hereby command
& make void all other wills & testaments by me hitherto made
& do ratify & confirm this & this alone to be my last will & testament
written my hand & seal hereunto annexed the 1st day of June
written ... signed, sealed, published & declared & set up in the
presence of John Black
