 ing this & no other to be my last will & testament in all respects
 I have hereunto applied my hand & seal this 18th day of May 1844

of this my last will & Testament & I do hereby Disannul
all former wills & Testaments by me heretofore
mentioned Nothing in this & no other to be my last will &
Testament in Writing by which I have hereunto set my
hand & seal this 5th day of July 1797.

horses & Cows necessary to carry on the for as best if she may
again them & in that case she is only to have a horse & saddle
her bed & furniture with all her Kitchen furniture & all
the great debts paid & she to have a Cow & Calf of her own
choise I give & bequeath to my Daughter Abigail one Cow
& calf & saddle & bed & furniture & to my Daughter Martha
one Negro & Mary Respell Rogers I give & bequeath to each
of them one Cow & calf & their families & to each of them
