As for my worldly Estate which it hath pleased God to bestow me with I desire it may be given after very discreet Expenses & first debts are paid as follows Viz I give & bequeath to my beloved wife ~~the~~ ^{my} plantation whereon to remain her life time & at her decease to my beloved son William Stewart his Heirs & assigns forever Stewart I give & bequeath the half of my land lying on twelve miles back the upper end of the Survey to my beloved son James Stewart his Heirs & assigns forever & the remainder of said tract to be sold & the money arising from said sale to be applyed in paying my debts. I bequeath to my beloved wife all my household furniture & plates 4 years & a month more & a common Horse & two cows & the largest of my Bulls, And the remainder of my Estate after debts are paid to be equally divided among my four daughters Viz Elizabeth, Mary & Jane Stewart And do hereby constitute & appoint my beloved wife Isabel Stewart & my dear friend James Houston as my Executrix to this my last will & Testament.
