widow & at the end of her widowhood I allow the land to
two boys William Sumnerville & Johnstone Sumnerville
& my son William my saddle own & above. I allow
my daughter Nancy Sumnerville a child part of the effects
or less of the land & my son William to give her a good
new saddle if she lives to the years of eighteen, I leave
my Children to be well schooled each of them out of the
own share. I allow Joseph Moore senr. & John Johnston to
be my whole & sole Executors, I do disannul & disallow
& revoke all other will or Wills heretofore made & this to be
my last will & Testament, I hereunto set my hand & seal
this 9th day of June 1796
