& testament that is to say Principally & first of all I give &
recommend my soul into the hand of Almighty God, that gave it
and my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in decent
Christian burial at the discretion of my executors nothing
doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the
same again by the mighty power of God, & as touching such
worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this
life, I give devise & dispose of the same in the following manner.
First I give & bequeath to my brother John Verner two Dollars
" 2^d I give & bequeath to my brother in law Jack McFaul two dollars
" 3^d I give & bequeath to my brother in law Andr. Allison two dollars
" 4^d I give & bequeath to my sister Sarah Verner two Dollars -
" 5^d I give & bequeath to my sister Rebecca Verner two Dollars
Lastly I give & bequeath to my Honored Mother Rebecca James
(after all my lawful debts is paid) all the remaining part of my
furniture, Horses, Cows, Hogs, farming Utensils, household
plenishing House & Lands & by her freely to be possessed & enjoyed
I also appoint & ordain James Tazert Esq with my Honored
Mother Rebecca Verner to be the sole executors of this my last
will & testament. And I do hereby utterly disallow & revoke
all & every former Testaments, Wills, or Legacies. Ratifying &
confirming this & no other to be my last will & testament
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand to
seal this 16th day of March in the year of our Lord 1800
