& Testament & Trustees for my wife & children in witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 24th day of
January 1825

my life — 2^d I give & bequeath to my son Thomas Alexander Wilson, the
tract of Land to which I now live at his mother's death, by him that said
Thomas Alexander Wilsons getting this tract of Land, It is my will that he
should not get an equal division of my estate with his sisters by the same
I give hundred dollars — 3^d I give & bequeath to Charles B Brown
my two little negroes named Abby & Humphrey, provided Charles Brown
live with me & living upon it is my will that the two negroes named to him
my Abby & Humphrey return to my estate & be divided equally between my
Wife & —

4th It is my Will that my Hony Tract of Land be equally divided
between my five Daughters — 5th It is my Will that all my childrens
Stock of Horses should be hired out until such time as some
of my Children should come of age, or become necessary to divide them.
6th It is also my Will that all my Estate not here before named should
be sold & divided equally amongst my wife & Children.
Lastly I do hereby appoint my Brother William J. Wilson & Dea
Joseph M. H. H. Executors of this my last Will & Testament

Hertfordshire State of Carolina, being weak in body but of
sound mind & memory, but calling to mind that it is appointed
for all men once to die; Do make & Ordain this my last Will and
Testament. — I recommend my Soul to Almighty God who gave it
and as touching such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased
God in this life to bestow, I do will & bequeath in the following
manner & form viz. — I will & bequeath to my beloved wife
Hannah during her Natural life or widowhood the one half of all the
Lands I possess including the House & improvement, where I now live
the Lands to be divided by two or three neighbours chosen by my Exrs
and also after sufficient property is sold to pay all my just debts
I leave to my said wife all the farming tools, household & Kitchen
furniture, all the Negroes & Stock of every kind, not hereafter
specially Willed, until my youngest Child comes of age to be
with her to help to raise & to heat the Children during her widowhood
I do further Will to my said wife her choice any Negroes & Horses
on the plantation to be found at her own disposal —
I will & bequeath to my Daughter Peggy Lucinda a Good horse
a saddle & bridle, two good Cows & Calves, a Bureau & some other
Household furniture as my Executors may think right likewise
a Negro Girl named Lucy. — I will & bequeath to my daughter
Susan a good horse saddle & bridle two good Cows & Calves
