23 In the Name of God Amen. March 30th 1829. I Robert Wilson of the
County of Marlboro^r & State of S^t Carolina, Being in a low state of health
but of sound mind & memory Do make this my last will & Testament in the
manner & form following viz First of all I give & bequeath to my wife
Margaret three hundred dollars of money that is now on hand & above
her share of my estate. It is also my will that my three negroes, named
Peter, big Mary & Linda be released to my wife in her sole. It is also my will that
my tools in the house & have the use of the land of land that I now live on during
my life & I give & bequeath to my son Thomas Alexander Wilson. The
tract of land wherein I now live at his mother's death, by him that said
Thomas Alexander Wilson getting this tract of land. It is my will that he
should not get an equal division of my estate with his sisters by the sum
of five hundred dollars. — give I give & bequeath On October 18th 1829
my two little negroes named Abby & Humpky, provided Master Brown
my master & having given it is my will that the money, now owing to him
my Abby & Humpky return to my estate & be divided & so it be between my
Heirs —

4th It is my will that my Harry tract of Land be equally divided
between my four Daughters — 5th It is my will that all my children
black & Negros should be hired out & take such time as some
of my children should come of age, or become incapable to divide them
6th It is also my will that all my Estate & heretofore unpaid should
be sold & divided equally amongst my wife & children.

Lastly I do hereby appoint my Brother William & Wilson & Doct
Joseph W. H. and his Executors of this my last Will & Testament

In the name of God known, I William Wallace of the County of
St. John's in the State of Carolina, being weak in body but of
sound mind & memory, but calling to mind that it is appointed
for all men Once to die, Do make & Ordain this, my last will and
Testament. I recommend my soul to Almighty God who gave it
and as touching such worldly estate herewith it hath pleased
God in this life to bestow, I do will & bequeath in the following
manner & form viz. Item, I will bequeath to my beloved wife
Hannah during her natural life or widowhood the one half of all the
lands I possess including the House & improvements, where I now live
the lands to be divided by two or three neighbors chosen by my Exec
and also after sufficient property is sold to pay all my just debts
I have to my said wife all the farming tools, household & kitchen
furniture, all the Negroes & Stock of every kind, not hereafter
specially willed, until my youngest child comes of age to be
with her to help to raise & school the children during her widowhood
& I do further will to my said wife her choice among the negroes & horses
in the plantation to be forever at her own disposal —

Item, I will bequeath to my Daughter Peggy Peninsula a Good horse
to saddle & bridle, two good Cows & Calves, a barrel & such other
Household furniture as my executors may think right likewise
a negro girl named Lucy. — Item, I will bequeath to my daughter
Susan Peninsula a good horse saddle & bridle two good Cows & Calves
