Lord to bless me with, I dispose of it in the following manner  
H<sup>t</sup>om, and first desirous of my first wife to be had —  
I give & bequeath to my well beloved wife Sarah Peoples all  
the worldly property that shee left in her hands during  
her life of weddedness, both at her marriage or death I  
allotted to be equally divided among all my children  
and in case any of them should be taken away by death  
in this non age fallen their part to be equally divided  
among the surviving ones, also leaving my well  
beloved wife Sarah Peoples an equal share in all the  
dole money & And lastly I do nominate & appoint  
my Trusty & beloved friend Col. John Davidson to be the  
whole & sole Executor of this my last will & Testament  
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand  
& affixed my seal this 1<sup>st</sup> day of October 1807 —

of Mecklenburg County State of North Carolina being at  
present weak in body, but of sound & disposing mind  
blessed be God, testifying to myself the 1<sup>st</sup> day of Oct<sup>r</sup>  
body that it is appointed all men once to die; I command  
that as in this my last will & Testament as now made and  
is now following, first, I recommend my soul to God who gave it  
and my body to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like

and devout manne at the dissolution of my beantes herein  
after mentioned; kind as touching such worldly estate as it hath  
pleased God to bestow me with in this life, I give & dispose of the  
same as follows viz First that my just debts & funeral expens  
es be paid & discharged as soon as convenient after my deceas  
e. I give & bequeath unto my four sons the plantation known  
to be equally divided between them. If any of  
them should die before they come of age, the rest of the boys  
to have their part, but then to their mother to have the living  
of either life time or as long as she remains my widow  
I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Susannah all the household  
& kitchen furniture & blacksmith tools his Horse to be  
all the slaves & horses to my son lower besides ten slaves & pigs  
to raise the family and as long as she remains my widow  
if she marries then things to be sold by executors if the two  
 negroes do not estate each five hundred & fifty dollars, I  
desire I have hired last winter times I do will and all the  
monies arising from the present sale with all my slaves  
in possession with all my outstanding debts to be equally  
divided between all my children only Margaret and  
Jacob Pennington, then I will give Dollars —

I hereby nominate constable & appoint William Houston  
the sole executor of this my last will & testament, hereby  
canceling all other will & testaments he testifies whereof I  
have set my hand & sign'd my book 20<sup>th</sup> November 1827
