 After I give to my son Esau. Twelve pounds & seven shillings & six pence
 Next I desire that there should be made a division of the plantation
 between the said Esau & my son Esau branch between of all
 share & house with the same all goods & chattels belonging
 to said Esau & I desire especially awarding my children after
 clearing off all debts except three pounds & six shillings the above
 said Esau wife as above. Next I desire that my two sons
 Benjamin & Samuel the plantation, which they now live
 the two parts of it tell their mother Elizabeth as above & with
 together the whole plantation to put into their hands
 After I have my wife & son Benjamin & Esau & Esau
 I desire that on the border the side encounter of
 this my last will & Testament, and also hereby utterly
 disallow, Revoke, Discontinue, and every other former
 Testament, Wills, Legacies, Bequests & Contrivances in
 any wise before named Wills & Legacies, Bequests
 confirming this & no other to be my last will & Testament
 In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal
 This 18th day of November in the Year of our Lord God 1764
 Signed, Sealed, Published, pronounced & attested by the
 said Samuel Biggs as his last will & Testament
