ner 1st It is my will & pleasure that all my last debts be paid —
Item 2nd I give unto my wife daughter Mary Ann my negro Girl Pegg
likewise a green Bond-bell Three years old —

Item 3rd I give unto my Daughter Mary Ellen my negro
Girl Sarah likewise a bed & furniture —

Item 4th I give unto my son Saml. Ann my negro Girl Peggy
and likewise a bed & furniture —

Item 5th The residue of my Property to be sold to the highest bidder
I appoint John Wilson & John C. Bane Executors
of this my Last Will & Testament in testimony
of my hand and seal 16th September 1852.

I give and bequeath of my Property in the following manner (M) My Negro namely Saml Julia Sarah Caniza & Chas & Thos Inward with my Interest in the Land in possession or may be ~~at~~ possession my death and also my right title & Interest in all the Stock of Horses & the Hags Shup & every species of property I own, or belonging to the estate to be equally divided among my two brothers & one Sister namely William John & Mary Byrnes either by selling the property and dividing the profits or dividing the property so that they may share & share alike provided at the death of either of the above named Legates without natural heirs the above will, & go to the Survivors or Survivor above named so much of it as may be left unexpended & when it falls into the hands of the last survivor it is to be at his or his disposal Entirely In testimony whereof I Samuel Byrnes of our aid do promiss & declare this to be my last will & Testament in presence of witnesses in the presence of them & each other have signed it our names this day of 1821
