given unto God & knowing that it is appointed for all men once
to die, Do make & declare this my last Will & to say principally
& first of all, I give & recommend my soul into the hands of
Almighty God that gave it & all the Devotion of my Body I
recommend it to the earth to be buried in a decent Christian
burial at the discretion of my Executors & as touching such
Worldly Estate which with it hath pleased God to bless me with
I give & dispose of in the following manner I give
First That Margaret my beloved wife besides what at the time has
provided for her shall have her maintenance off of the plantation
while she lives unmarried & I like wife will that Geo Alexander
shall be my Executor to administer & pay all the just
Demands against the Estate.

- 2^d I give my beloved son Benjamin five shillings Sterling to be paid out of
the plantation.
 - 3^d I give to my beloved son James the whole of my plantation and the
privileges thereof except what is before mentioned and I do
hereby will that he shall have the children that is to school
out of the benefit of the plantation.
 - 4th That my beloved daughter Sophia shall have five shillings Ster-
ling paid out of the plantation.
 - 5th That I authorize division be made of the remainder of my
Estate among the rest of my children.

by the said Samuel Brown as his last Will and
