 with som sheep & the black pairing horse with a foal in his foal  
 I do bequeath unto my son Samuel Caryl 100 acres of the plantation  
 on which I now live including my improvements with my black  
 stall of clothes & the 1 with the large black horse & the grey horse  
 I do likewise allow that she; until the time twelve months shall  
 be over more than cost of living be sold to discharge some part of the  
 money due toward the last unto my debts in the Country I desire  
 when collected to be paid toward discharging of the said debts  
 I do give & bequeath unto my son Joseph Caryl 100 acres of Land  
 belonging to the same tract joining Joseph Gabreath the said John  
 Caryl my eldest son pays said Joseph the first 100 together with the  
 interest I allow him to get the said 100 acre from Joseph & if no  
 Joseph to keep the full property of the land & not to part with it till  
 the money is paid & to my two daughters Henry & Margaret the  
 County of Hanes Coos & Sherriff to have the same claim they are  
 keep the rest property to be at their own disposal each of said girls  
 to have a bed wth them what they now claim & their appurtenances  
 as to have likewise in that which they now possess and the remaining  
 part of the Household furniture to my wife I do give & bequeath  
 to my son John Caryl two hundred & threty years. The  
 remaining part of the stock with Samuel, Joseph to divide  
 as the see cause I do constitute William Willcott & Son  
 Wickerson my executors of this my last will & testament  
 & trustees for my wife & children In witness whereof I do
