Item I Order & it is my will that if my beloved wife shall change her mind that shall have her dower or third as the Law directs out of the contents in my name during her natural life she is fully to enjoy what I Order Above, at her death what remains of lands & goods or what else she shall be equally among my children

Item I nominate & appoint my said loving wife Jane Craighead & John Davis of this County to be my Executors of this my last Will & Testament, And lastly I do annul & make void all former wills & Testaments by me made whether in word or writing & declare this only to be my last Will & Testament in writing whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this ninth day of April one Thousand seven hundred & sixty five

To my Daughter Jane Cathey I bequeath one good bed, bedstead & furniture, one horse known by being called her own with harness & saddle & Twenty pounds in money or trade with a good maintenance of my farm during her life if she live single To my son George Cathey I bequeath the sum of pounds in money -

To my Daughter Mary Ann I bequeath one Negro three years old and five pounds in money -

To my son Alexander Cathey I bequeath one Negro boy named
