In the name of God Amen. I James Ferguson of the State of N.C. a citizen  
of Mecklenburg County being weak in body but of perfect mind & memory  
do make my Last Will & Testament unto God Almighty unto know the Mortality of my  
body Yknowing that it is appointed for a man once to die  
do make & ordain this my last Will & Testament that is to say principally & first  
of all I give & recommend my soul into the hand of Almighty God that  
gave it to my body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a Decent  
Manner at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at  
the General Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the Almighty  
power of God. And as touching such worldly estate where with it has  
pleased God to bless me with another life, And in the first place I desire  
that all my lawful debts be paid & then rest to be disposed of in the  
following manner & form. 2<sup>d</sup> Viz I give & bequeath unto my beloved  
Son Alexander Ferguson two Young Negroes one girl named Sally  
the other a boy named Jeremiah - and I also give & bequeath unto  
my Daughter Agape Ferguson three Negroes Viz one Negro was her name  
Ann & two Negro boys one named Matthew & the other David - and it  
also is my Will & pleasure that my Negroes before made abide with  
my family till I make on the plantation after this delivery & then  
to be valued or appraised & divided between my Son & Daughter -  
and as to the rest of my real & personal estate with the sum of  
~~Heastation~~ I will & do hereby order that it stand as in a Deed  
of gift on record excepting one third of my real & personal estate  
with the use of the plantation to my beloved wife Molly Ferguson  
during her life to me or wedowhood and no longer -  
And I do hereby appoint & ordain my beloved wife Molly Ferguson  
my beloved & dearest daughter exhibited Campbell my trusty friend  
George Corzine head to be my whole & sole Executrix to this my last  
Will & Testament & to hereby administer & sell all my lands &  
disannal all my debts & to pay my debts by me  
settled or made and to do hereby certify & confess this

I have hereunto set my hand & seal this sixteenth day of  
October in the year of our Lord 1796.

state of health, the<sup>r</sup> of said mind & memory, willing to mind the  
mortality of my body howevering all man need see, do make &  
execute this my last Will & Testament viz I give my soul to Almighty  
God who has given it from body to the dust to be buried at the discretion  
of my executors, and as touching such worldly estate as it hath  
pleased God to bestow me with in this life I will give by will  
& dispose of in the following manner & form -

Item I will give & bequeath to John Fraser my beloved son (if yet alive)  
the sum of five shillings -

I will give & bequeath to William Fraser my beloved son five shillings  
I give & bequeath to Martha Robison my beloved daughter five shillings  
I Will Give & bequeath one hundred acres of land over to Joseph Fraser my  
beloved son to him & to his heirs & assigns for ever one hundred acres of  
land being part of this big tract of 250 acres on which the said Joseph  
now lives including his improvements which said 100 acres is to be laid  
off said big tract agreeable to the directions of Joseph Moore & John W.  
Alexander & their Just. & heirs confirmed to him -

I give & bequeath to James Fraser my son all my right to the house  
house which is now run away -

I will give, bequeath, enfeoff, & cause to go to my beloved son  
Samuel Fraser & my said beloved son James Fraser to them the  
three heirs & assigns for ever all the residue & remainder of my land  
to be equally divided between them as to directly, quantity as  
near as may be by my executors Joseph Moore & Joseph Frame  
& like wise with the assistance of Robert Alexander as the
