In the name of God Amen. I Samuel Johnston of the County of
Hicklenburg & State of N Carolina, being in a weakly state
of Health but of sound mind & memory thanks be to God therefore
calling to mind the mortality of my body & knowing that it is
appointed for all men once to die, Do make & Ordain this my
last Will & Testament, That is to say principally & first of all
I give my Soul into the hands of almighty God that gave it,
& my body I recommend to the dust to be buried in a decent
manner at the discretion of my Executors; and as Touching
my worldly Estate whereunto it hath pleased God to bless
me in this life I give & dispose of the same in the following
manner & give Viz. I Give & bequeath unto Cynthia Johnston
my beloved wife the plantation on which I now live dur-
ing we do live & all her dower to be sold to the highest
bidder & the net proceeds divided equally among all my
children then alive; It is further my will that my
wife Cynthia have my Negro Woman Phillis & her four
children Viz Andrew, Edy, Nancy, Hannah to enable
her to raise & school my children & as they come to the
age of Twenty one years that they receive that part of my
estate that two indifferent persons may think they are
intitled to, It is further my will that my wife Cynthia
have two Servant men & one Colt, also nine head of cattle
her choice, also Twelve head of Hogs her choice also six
head of sheep her choice, also all the farming Utensils

together with my plantation waggon & gear, also all the household
furniture & cupboards / furniture, also one team & packhorses, also a
much of the corn & meat as will be sufficient to support the family
until the next crop is gathered. It is my will that my negro
boy Isaac remain with my wife this year & if she thinks proper
he be hired out here after & the money arising from said hire
to go to the payment of my debts; It is my will that all the
residue or remainder of my Estate not before disposed in this will
should be put to sale by my Executors here after named -

I do hereby constitute & appoint Mr. Alexander & Oswald Alexander
to be my sole Executors to execute this my last will & testament
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal
this 7th day of May in the year of our Lord 1825 -

the blessings of sound mind & memory, calling to view the uncertainty
of life, do make this instrument of writing my last will & testame-
ment in manner & form following. First it is my
will & I do Order that all my just debts & funeral charges
be paid. - 2^d It is my will & I do Order that my beloved wife Priscilla
have one hundred & ten acres of Land including the dwelling house
the same being the part of my tract of Land that was surveyed &
marked off commonly called the home lot during her life, which
land at her decease shall descend to my youngest daughter
Priscilla I do further give & bequeath to my beloved wife Priscilla
my negro boy named Richard Franklin, also all the household &
kitchen furniture (except one bed & furniture) to be hers and at
her own disposal, also my Dead House

3^d It is my will & I do Order that my daughter Annea have one
hundred acres of Land lying in the south east corner of my Land marked
in the plat of division of my Land & 4th It is my will & I do Order
that my daughter Maria have one hundred
