And Lastly I hereby make & ordain my beloved sons John & Thomas Boyd
Executors of this my last will & Testament, Reserving all others, the last will
of the said Elizabeth Heron here written in this my last will & Testament
in my hand & date this day & year above written.


In the name of God Amen. I Samuel Harris of the County of Mecklenburg
& State of N^o Carolina being of sound & perfect mind & memory blessed be God
calling to mind the mortality of my body & knowing it is appointed for
all men once to die, I make & ordain this my last will & Testament &
first I recommend my soul to God who gave it, & my body to the earth
to be buried in a Christian & decent manner at the discretion of my
Executors here after named, As touching such worldly goods as the Lord has
blessed me with I do dispose of it in the following manner & order, To my wife
Rebecca two hundred & seventy six Dollars to be paid one year after my
death, I also will to my wife my negro woman Hannah & her two young
children also my Liberty Horse in saddle & bridle, three cows & calves
one pair of oxen, one pair of geese, one hen, one cock, also one bed & furniture
also my chest of drawers held by Roger Tabbe Simons & one half dozen
in tea &c, also one half of the dresser furniture to her & hers forever

I also will to my wife one third of the plantation I now live on to be
 off by men appointed for that purpose, it is my will that my wife have
 third of the barn room & one third of the Groats & also my Manseon
 but not to the exclusion of my Grand daughter Sarah H Harris &
 Grand son Isaac Harris if the choasation in it, I also will to my
 wife my Negro fellow Jack all which begins at term & I will to
 clearing his widowhood or natural life after which time I will go
 to my son Laid H Harris to him & his Heirs forever. Item I will to my
 Step daughter Doves Johnston & Isabella or Twenty five Dollars each
 Item I will to my son Sermon Harris Three hundred Dollars -
 Item I will to my son Robert Harris Three hundred Dollars also my neg
 woman Nan to him & his Heirs forever.
 Item I will to my Grand daughter Margaret Horriate Harris one hundred
 & fifty dollars to her & her Heirs forever -
 Item I will to my Grand daughter Sarah H Harris two hundred & fifty
 dollars also a Bureau, one bed & furniture, also one half of the dress
 furniture to her & her Heirs forever, also a Saddle & Bridle -
 Item I will to my Grand son Isaac Harris two hundred dollars to him
 his Heirs forever, I also will to Isaac a Saddle & Bridle -
 Item I will to my Grand daughter Caroline Harris Three hundred & fifty
 Dollars to her & her Heirs forever. all which Legacy is to be placed
 the hands of their Guardians till they are Twenty one year of age
 ing Interest one year after my death, but if any of them should
 before they are of age of Twenty one, then it is my will that the legacy
 to be equally divided among the Survivors, it is also my will
 that Sarah H Harris & Isaac Harris be raised & educated & clothed out
 my estate at the discretion of the Guardian. Item I will to my Grand

 Item I will to my Grand daughter Margaret Horick Harris one hundred
 & fifty dollars to her & her heirs forever -
 Item I will to my Grand daughter Sarah & Harris two hundred & fifty
 dollars also a Burrell, one bed & furniture, also one half of the drop
 furniture to her & her heirs forever, also a Saddle & Bridle -
 Item I will to my Grand son Isaac Harris two hundred dollars to him
 his heirs forever, I also will to Isaac a Saddle & Bridle -
 Item I will to my Grand daughter Caroline Harris three hundred & fifty
 Dollars to her & her heirs forever. All which Legacies is to be paid
 the hands of their Guardians till they are Twenty one years of age
 -ing Interest one year after my death, but if any of them should
 becom they are of age of Twenty one, then it is my will that the leg-

 my negro woman Patience, to her & her heirs forever, I also will my
 daughter Martha three hundred dollars to be paid one year after
 death. Item I will to my daughter Mary fifteen my negro w-
 -Mal, also three hundred dollars to be paid one year after death
 & her heirs forever. Item I will to my daughter Margaret for her
 two hundred & seventy five Dollars, also six Colours, one feather
 and furniture, two cows & Calves, two Swines & Lamb's to her & her

Item, I Will to my daughter Waltera Harris two hundred & seventy five dollars
 I also Will to my daughter Evaleine fifty dollars in place of the Cattle &
 Sheep that the cost of my Children has received to be paid one year after my
 death to her & her heirs forever. Item, I Will to my Daughter Jane McCon-
 nels, Two hundred & seventy five dollars, also half dozen chairs, two beds
 & a number to her & her heirs forever. Item I Will & bequeath to my Grandson
Samuel C. Harris my Negro girl Betsy Selina to him & his heirs forever
 the said Samuel C. Harris to pay his brother Elam S. Harris eighty dollars
 one year after my death. Item, I Will to Eliza Ferguson four Children
 one hundred dollars to be equally divided among them. Item I Will to
 my son Said H. Harris all the plantation I now live on Excepting the part
 allotted to my wife during her widowhood or natural life to him & his
 heirs forever, also my Desk & book case, also my watch, also my negro
 woman Nashed to him & his heirs forever, also one hundred Dollars in
 cash or notes. Item it is my will that my Library of books be divided
 among my wife & my own Children. Item It is my will that my wearing
 apparel be as equally as possible divided among my male Grand Children
 Item It is my will that the negroes & other property not herein mentioned
 bequeathed be exposed to public sale & it is my will that the money
 arising from such sale be equally divided among all my Children
 not including my son Samuel Harris, one Children, so one tenth part
 of it is also my will that my Daughter Jones Children receive one tenth
 part of the whole of the balance of my Estate after the various legacies
 & one hundred Dollars to some Charitable use to be apply'd at the
 discretion of my Executors. And Lastly I do appoint my son David
Harris & my Trusty friends Jonathan Harris & John Gingles to be
 my whole & sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament & do
 hereby disannul & revoke all other Wills & Testaments or bequeath-
 ments heretofore made or mentioned, Ratifying & confirming this
 to be my last Will & Testament, In witness hereunto I
 set my hand & seal this 11th day of June 1824 -

one hundred dollars to be equally divided among them. Then I Will to
my son Said H. Harris all the plantation I now live on Excepting the part
 allotted to my wife during her widowhood or natural life to him & his
Heirs forever, Also my Desk & book case, Also my watch, Also my negro
servant Rachel to him & his Heirs forever, Also one hundred Dollars in
cash or notes. Then it is my will that my Library of books be divided
among my wife & my own Children. Then it is my will that my wearing
apparel be as equally as possible divided among my male Grand children
Then it is my will that the Negroes & other property not herein mentioned
bequeathed be exposed to public sale & it is my will that the money
arising from such sale be equally divided among all my Children
not including my son Learning Harris, one Child for one tenth part
It is also my will that my Daughter Dorcas Children receive one tenth
part of the balance of the balance of my Estate after the various legacies
& one hundred Dollars to some Charitable use to be applied at the
discretion of my Executors. And Lastly I do appoint my son Said
Harris & my Trusty friends Jonathan Harris & John Gingles to be
my sole & sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament & do
solely disavow & revoke all other Wills & Testaments or bequests
made here before made or mentioned, Ratifying & confirming this
to be my last Will & Testament, In witness hereunto I
set my hand & seal this 17th day of June 1824.
