buried & equally divided between them. To my son in law Robert
Ferguson & Francis Simcock each one Dollar.

And Lastly I hereby make & ordain my beloved sons, John & Thomas Boyd
executors of this my last will & Testament, Reserving all others. The last wills
written by Mr. & Mrs. Samuel Henson have in this my last will & Testament
in my hand & seal the day & year above written.

In the name of God amen. I Samuel Harris of the County of Mecklenburg
State of Carolina being of sound & perfect mind & memory before God
calling to mind the mortality of my body & knowing it is appointed for
all men once to die, I make & declare this my last will & Testament the
first I recommend my soul to God who gave it, & my body to the Earth
to be buried in a Christian & decent manner at the discretion of my
executors here after named, in touching such worldly goods as the Lord has
given me with his disposal of it in the following manner & form, to my wife
Jane my first wife, be paid. Item I will & bequeath to my beloved wife
Bebecca two hundred & seventy five Dollars to be paid one year after my
death, I also will to my wife my negro woman Hannah & her two young
& children Also my library now in said the Hobbie, three hundred dollars
per annum, one pair of years, one horse, one cow, also one bed & furniture
from my chest of Drawers to be given to her & her children
in her do, also one half of the drawer furniture taken & hers partitioned

I also will to my wife one third of the plantation I now live on to be
off by men appointed for that purpose. It is my will that my wife have
one third of the Barn room & one third of the Crooked & also my Mansions
but not to the Exclusion of my Grand daughter Sarah A Harris &
Grand son Isaac Harris if she chooses to live in it, I also will to my
wife my Negro settler Jack all which begins at my death I will to
during her widowhood or natural life after which time I will go
to my son Isaac A Harris to him & his Heirs forever. Item. I will to my
Stepdaughter Dorcas Johnston & Isabella or Twenty five Dollars each
Item. I will to my son Samuel Harris three hundred Dollars —
Item. I will to my son Robert Harris three hundred Dollars also my Neg
woman Nannie to him & his Heirs forever.
Item. I will to my Granddaughter Margaret Morris Harris one hundred
Dollars also her & her Heirs forever —
Item. I will to my Granddaughter Sarah A Harris two hundred & fifty
Dollars also a Bursall, one bed & furniture, also one half of the dress
furniture to her & her Heirs, forever, also a Saddle & Bridle —
Item. I will to my Grandson Isaac Harris two hundred dollars to him
his Heirs, forever, I also will to Isaac a Saddle & Bridle —
Item. I will to my Granddaughter Caroline Harris three hundred & fifty
Dollars to her & her Heirs forever. All which Legacies is to be placed
in the hands of their Guardians till they are Twenty one years of Age
bearing Interest one year after my death, but if any of them should
die before they are of age of Twenty one, then it is my will that the lego
be to be equally distributed among the Survivors. It is also my will
that Sarah A Harris & Isaac Harris be raised & educated & clothed out
of my estate at the discretion of the Guardian. Item. I will to my Grand

 the hands of their Guardians till they are Twenty one years of age
 bearing Interest one year after my death, but if any of them should

 Kate, also three hundred dollars to be paid one year after death to
 her & her heirs forever. Item. I will to my daughter Margaret for me
 one hundred & twenty five Dollars, also six Pounds, one bushel
 and four fifths, two loins & Cakes, two Ewes & Lambs taken & killed

Him. I will to my Daughter Lucina Harris two hundred & twenty five dollars
I also will to my daughter Elizabeth fifty dollars in place of the cattle to
keep that the rest of my children has received to her paid one year after my
death to her & her Heirs forever. Item. I Will to my Daughter Jane Wilson
two hundred & twenty five dollars, also half wagon chairs, two horses
& slender to her other Heirs forever. Item I will a big ox cart to my grandson
Samuel C. Harris my Negro girl Betsey Johnson to him & his Heirs forever
Mr. John Samuel C. Harris to pay his brother Elam S. Harris eighty dollars
one year after my death. Item. I Will to Eliza Ferguson four children
one hundred dollars to be equally divided among them. Item I Will to
my son Isaac H. Harris all the plantation I now have on Escarpin the just
settled to my wife during her widowhood or natural life to him & his
Heirs forever. Also my Desk & book case, Also my Watch, Also my negro
woman Parker to him & his Heirs forever, Also one hundred Dollars in
cash or water. Item it is my will that my Library of books be divided
among my wife & my own children. Item It is my will that my money
I expect be as equally as possible divided among my male Grandchildren
Item It is my will that the Negroes & other property not herein mentioned
be purchased to be disposed of publickly Yet is my will that the money
arising from such sale be equally divided among all my children
not including my son Isaac H. Harris, one childern, to one tenth part
Yet is also my will that my Daughter Doreas children receive one tenth
part of the whole of the Balance of my Estate left. The Vessells belonging
to me less. One Thousand Dollars to some Charitable use to be applied at the
discretion of my Executors. And Lastly I do appoint my Son Isaac
Harris & my Trusty friends Jonathan Harris & John Gingles to be
my sole & sole trustees of this my last will & Testament & I do
hereby disown & revoke all other wills & Testaments or bequests
ments heretofore made or mentioned, Ratifying & confirming this
to be often to be my last will & Testament, In witness whereunto I
set my hand & seal this 17th day of June 1824.

Cash or Notes. Item it is my will that my Library of books be divided
among my wife & my own children. Item. It is my will that my Library
of Books be as equally as possible divided among my wife & grand children
Item. It is my will that the negroes & other property not herein mentioned
bequeathed be exposed to public sale. Yet it is my will that the money
arising from such sale be equally divided among all my children
not including my son Lawrence Harris, one child to one tenth part.
Yet it is also my will that my Daughter Dorcas' children receive one tenth
part of the whole of the balance of my estate left. The Warrenton legacies
I give him. One hundred Dollars to some Charitable use to be applied at the
discretion of my executors. And finally I do appoint my son Law-
rence Harris & my Trusty friend Jonathan Harris & John Gingles to be
my whole & sole executors of this my last Will & Testament & do
hereby disown & revoke all other wills & Testaments, or bequeath-
ments here before made or mentioned, Ratifying & confirming this
the 10th day to be my last Will & Testament, In witness whereunto I
set my hand & seal this 17th day of June 1824.
