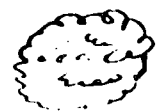

Do make & Ordain this my last will & Testament, that is to say
I give my soul to Almighty God that gave it and my Body I
recommend to the Earth to be buried in a Christian decent
manner at the discretion of my Executors, And as touching
my worldly Estate what so the blessed God shall bless me with
I will give & dispose of in the following manner & form to wit
I will give & bequeath to my beloved Mother one third of
the plantation on which I now live during her natural life
It is my further will & pleasure that my plantation be
appraised as to the & equally divided between my two Brothers
to wit that is to say William, James & Elizabeth Long I have
also the Survivors to be due to the deceased —
I will give & bequeath to my beloved brother John Long the
sum of five pounds. — It is my will & pleasure that the remain-
der of my Estate if any there be, be divided among my surviving
Brothers & Sisters — and Lastly I do appoint Wm & James Brooke
James & Andrew, & Andrew Elliot my sole Executors of this
my last will & Testament, Reserving all former wills, gifts
or bequeathments by me made or given, Confirming this to be no
other to be my last will & Testament. In Witness whereof I have
set my hand & affixed my seal this 10th day of July 1801
