manner at the discretion of my executors, and as touching  
such worldly Estate as it shall please God to bless me with  
I will give & dispose of in the following manner & form viz  
Item. I will give & bequeath to my beloved Mother one third of  
the plantation on which she now live during her natural life  
Item. It is my further will & pleasure that my plantation be  
appraised at the currently divided between my two brothers  
& sister that is to say William, James & Elizabeth Long & their  
eldest son & heir to the same

Item. I will give & bequeath to my beloved brother John Long the  
sum of Five pounds. - it is my will & pleasure that the remainder  
of my Estate if any there be divided among my surviving  
brother & sisters - and first I do appoint James & John  
Long & Andrew Elliott my sole Executors of this  
my last will & Testament. Revoking all former Wills, gifts  
or bequests made by me made or given, Confirming this bid no  
other to be my last Will & Testament. The witness whereof I have  
set my hand & affixed my seal this 10<sup>th</sup> day of July 1801
