and I, to hereby nominate & appoint my beloved wife Margaret  
Monts to be my sole executrix of this my last will & testament  
overseeing all other wills & testaments heretofore by me made.

pointed for all men once to die, Do make & declare in this my last will  
& testament, that I do say principally & first of all I give & recommend  
my soul unto the hand of God that gives it, and for my body I recom-  
mend it to the earth to be buried in a Christian manner, nothing  
doubtless but at the general resurrection. I shall receive the same  
again by the mighty power of God, and as touching some worldly  
estate I leave with it but the pleasure God to bestow in this  
life. I give & bequeath the same in manner & form following  
that is to say, First I give & bequeath to my wife wife Cathie  
Rogers the one third of my personal estate Except the two Tides,  
my Negro woman Dolly & the maintenance of this table while  
she remains to widow, and I allow all my personal estate to be

Oppenited by these first her letters off the 29<sup>th</sup> instant, Comd & delivered to  
my Sons Samuel & Joseph for the chold, that my late beloved wife is  
great with child a boy the house shall have an equal share of the land, of  
the said land shall be valued as apportioned & between my estate is valued  
it shall be equally divided amongst all my children only the two  
stills, I give to my trustees Samuel & Joseph the largest still being for  
Samuel & the smaller for Joseph. And I do Ordain & appoint Stephen  
McKenzie & Charles my beloved wife my lawful Executrix of this my  
last will & Testament, And I do hereby utterly disallow & disannul  
all former little former Testaments, the witness whereof I have here  
unto set my hand & seal the day & year above written  
Signed, Sealed, Pronounced & Declared that this writing is his  
last will & Testament in the presence of us
