

Clothing my Children & my beloved wife Isabella is to have her

Daughters & by their present I do impower my Executors or
either of them to make a Deed of Sale for the same, as far as
Child yet unborn I do will & bequeath if a boy what he
can be purchased on the western waters with my Incident, &
no land can be got, in them he must have an equal part
my Daughters & if a Daughter she is to share an equal part in
the rest of the land if any to be sold & equally divided among
my Daughters I do allow the two year old filly to be kept
along with the two horses for the use of the family, and the
foal more than three year old filly to be sold & what money
can possibly be spared - And lastly I do nominate & appoint
my wife Isabella & her Husband William Henderson Esq^r. and my
beloved Cousin John Steep to be my Executrix of this my last
will & Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand & affixed my seal this October the 5th 1788 -

In the name of God amen. I am now laid Harris do make
& declare this to be my last will & Testament, & I hereby
revoke & recall all former wills & Testaments made, or to be made
in the first place I do require my Executors to make such pro-
vision out of my property as shall appear in their discretion
to be most suitable & proper for the payment of all my law-
ful debts & to have my Estate settled & clear of incumbrance
& debts as soon as can be done with safety -

I do will & bequeath all my share of the land I inherit from
my Father's Estate lying in Gloucester big sum hundred pounds
equally divided between my Brother & Sisters there nothing else
I do order & declare that all my other property etc. shall
be the last legatee at the discretion of my Executors

Except the Land I bought of William Harris — I do will & declare that the Management of the aforesaid Land I bought of William Harris shall be left absolutely at the discretion of my Executrix either to hold it or sell it & I do hereby invest them with full powers either to hold it or sell it according as it may appear to them to be most advantageous for my family. I do hereby will & ordain that my beloved wife Mary & the child she is now pregnant with shall be equal heirs of all my worldly goods & property of whatsoever kind whether personal or real except the land before mentioned lying in Tennessee — I do declare that my wife Mary be put in possession of her share of my Estate immediately or as soon as can be done with propriety & advantage. I do declare that the Child's share be retained in the hands of my Executrix or such Guardians as may be appointed to be applied to the Education & necessary expenses of the Child. I do also declare that if the Child, of which my beloved wife Mary is now pregnant should die before it arrives to maturity or while it is in a state of minority that then & in that case the same interest all the above shares that I have declared shall be I do leave it discretionary with my Executrix in what form the property had best be reserved for my Child & that it shall be distributed in such form & manner as they shall judge most expedient. I do also declare that my beloved wife Mary be consulted their interpretation had in all things relating to the Education & General Management of the Child. — I ordain that my Negro Girl Betty shall make a part of my wife's share of my Estate at the rate of Two hundred & Twenty five Dollars — I do declare my Brother Jonathan my Brother in law Alexander Anderson & Dr. J. Cunningham Harris to be executors of this my last will & Testament, which I do hereby acknowledge to have signed & executed this 9th day of August 1798.
