head of hogs & one Deer Steer; I do hereby give my Daugh-
ter Margret ten acres of land including the house
where she now lives, & I do hereby give my grand
daughter Lucy one Steer heifer, & I
do hereby give my son Nicholas fifty acres of land
& one pickled heifer - Signed & delivered in the
presence of us - I do appoint William Shook and
George Richardson for my Executors

County of North Carolina & State of N^c Carolina being in a
weak & low state of Health but of sound memory & judgment
do make & constitute this my last will & Testament
Item 1st I bequeath my body to the dust to be buried in a
decent manner at the discretion of my executor
Item 2nd I allow all my just debts to be, paid -
Item 3rd To my beloved Sister, Polly Cunningham I
bequeath my bay horse Shakespeare, Item 4th To my niece
Fanny Caroline Moore I bequeath the ten dollars in Cash
Item 5th To John Semison two sons Henry & John I bequeath
ten dollars to be divided equally; Item 6th To William
Harris I bequeath twenty five dollars; Item 7th To my
brother John Semison I bequeath the balance of my
estate, also my wearing apparel if he returns to this
Country, & otherwise to revert to my Executor -
Signed and executed as my last & died this 27th day

December 1805 - Lastly I constitute & appoint my friend
James Harris the sole Executor of this my last Will &
Testament

In the name of God Amen, I John Swann of Newblunbury
County, State of N Carolina, being weak in body but of sound
& disposing mind & memory do make & declare this my last Will
& Testament in manner & form following viz Imprimis
I leave to my son William Swann five dollars & no further
divide of my Estate. Item I leave to my daughter Margt
Hutchison one feather bed & furniture & no further divide
of my Estate. Item I leave to my son John Swann one
Cow & one yearling Heifer or there & the one third part of all
the Sheep I now possess & no further divide of my Estate
Item I leave to my son Joseph Swann one young Bay
mare & the one half of the remainder of my Stock of cattle
& Sheep & one feather bed & furniture & one half of my
Kitchen furniture & all my plantation tools that I
at this time possess & no further divide of my Estate
Item I leave to my daughter Dorcas Swann the
plantation whereon I now live with all the appur-
tenances thereto belonging one feather bed & furniture
& all my household & dresser furniture & the one
half of my Kitchen furniture & the remainder of
my Stock of Cattle & Sheep. And it is my will & desire
that my son Joseph Swann pays my son William Swann the
five dollars left to him in this my will, & I do hereby re-
-minde & appoint my two sons John Swann & Joseph Swann
Executors of this my last Will & Testament, and I do hereby revoke
& disannul all other Wills by me at any time made either by
word or writing & pronounce this & this only to be my last Will &
Testament & I do hereby declare that I have no other Will & Testament
