In The Name of God Amen. I Samuel Wilson
of Mecklenburg County in the State of N^o Carolina
being sick & in a low state of health, but of sound
mind & memory, calling to mind the frequent dis-
locations of my body, Do make & ordain this my last
Will & Testament that is to say principally & first of all
I give my soul unto the hands of Almighty God
who gave it; & my body I commend to the Earth

I will bequeath in manner at the discretion
of my Executor, And as touching such lands &c by
which wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me lies
in this life. I will give, bequeath & dispose of the same
in the following manner & form viz
I promise. I Will, Give & bequeath unto my beloved wife
Margret Wilson the sum of Two hundred & fifty
pounds, & further bid & furniture thereunto belonging
her Saddle & Bridle & the Eagle mare & it is my further
will & pleasure that my said wife Margret be per-
mitted the better to enable her to cloath & raise
our young children peaceably to occupy the
Garden & live in the Mansion house & have the
Labour & service of negro Peter during his widowhood
& the better to enable her to raise cloath & apparel
free of any charge our said young children to be fed
out on Kitchen & household furniture at her discre-
tion, I further will & bequeath unto my said beloved
wife Margret the further sum of one hundred & thirty
five pounds. Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved
Daughter Violet Davidson the sum of Twenty Shillings
Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved son Benjamin
Wilson the sum of Twenty Shillings -
Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved daughter Mary
Patte the sum of Twenty Shillings -
Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved son David Wilson
the sum of Twenty Shillings -
Item I will, give, bequeath; Ensign transfer & it over unto my
beloved son John Wilson a negro man named Plumb
Mare, a horse & a filly generally known as his own
creatures, & the one half of the plantation on which
I now live being part of two surveys to be equally
divided in quantity by a line or lines which is to be
granted directed & marked by Cap^t Richard Barry
I my son Benjamin Wilson hereby allowing
my said son for his choice of either mostly
& also the one half of a six hundred acre so

Burk County known by the name of the 2d bank —
which said Survey is to be equally divided by my son
in law John Deasdon & my said son Benjamin Wilson

Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved daughter Margaret
Wilson one black filly two years old with a star in
her forehead (one of somuch beauty & good new saddle
& bridle, & good new feather bed & furniture, & four
Cows, and the sum of Twenty pounds —

Item I will give, bequeath out of my estate over unto my
beloved son Robert Wilson all the remaining Moiety or
half of this plantation on which I now live, & the one
Moiety or half of the thousand six hundred acres in Burk
County, hereby allowing him the said Robert his
Guardian or my Executors to have the choice of either
Moiety or half and the sum of Twenty pounds —

Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved daughter Sarah
Wilson the sum of Two hundred pounds —

Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved daughter Lilly
Wilson the sum of Two hundred pounds —

Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved daughter Charity
Wilson the sum of Two hundred pounds —

Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved son Samuel
Wilson the sum of Twenty Shillings —

Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved grandson Samuel
Polk the sum of Fifty pounds —

Item I will & bequeath unto my beloved grandson Samuel
Wilson the sum of Fifty pounds —

Item It is my further will & pleasure & I hereby will
& bequeath unto the infant which my beloved wife
Margaret Wilson is now pregnant with the sum
of One hundred pounds — It is further my will to
pleasure that all the remainder of my negroes
goods & chattels be sold by my executors and after
paying all my just debts & the aforesaid legacies
that the remainder be equally divided among
my aforesaid children viz John, Margaret, Sarah,
Robert, Lilly, Charity, & the above said infant

It is further will & pleasure that if John or Robert
should die before the arrival at the age of Twenty
one years leaving no Heirs of their body, that then the
whole Majority of Lands shall be sold by my Executors
hereafter named which they are hereby fully enabled
to do, & the Money or Monies there arising shall be
Equally divided among all their surviving brothers
& their other Estate & Divisions shall be equally
divided among all their surviving brothers & sister
And if any of my daughters should die before the
arrival at the age of Twenty one years leaving no
Heir of their body, then their Share & divisions
shall be Equally divided among all my surviving
children, It is my further will & pleasure that the
above said Legacies be paid out on Interest wthd
good Security & increased for the Benefit of the legatees
until they severally arrive at the age of Twenty one
years - And lastly I do hereby nominate and
appoint my Son in law John Henderson & my son
Benjamin Wilson & Samuel Wilson to be my two
Executors of this my last Will & Testament, &
hereby revoking all former Wills, Gifts & bequests
by me made or done, Ratifying & confirming the
same to be my last Will & Testament - In
Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand
& affixed my Seal this 9th day of March 1778 -
Signed Sealed published pronounced & declared
by the said Samuel Wilson as his last Will
& Testament, who in his presence & in the
presence of each other have hereunto
