 N^c Carolina Mecklenburg County, being sick in body, but
 of good & perfect mind & memory, calling to Remembrance
 the mortality of my body & that it is appointed for all men
 once to die, Do make & ordain this my last will & Testament
 in the manner & form following; And as touching such
 worldly estate as it hath pleased God to bless me with
 I give & dispose in the subsequent manner & form viz.
Imprimis I give & bequeath to my oldest son John five
 shillings, & to Samuel Rogers five shillings -
Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Mary my loom &
 Tacklings & what bedding is in the house to my two
 daughters Mary & Esther, I give & bequeath to my
 daughter Esther a horse at the same value, I give &
 bequeath to my son George the young grey horse saddle
 & bridle & the plantation that I live on with the place
 & all the plantation Tacklings that the now have with
 my house hold, And I give & bequeath all my clothes
 to my son George, & all that remains to my two daughters
Mary & Esther, In Witness whereof I have hereunto set
 my hand & seal, I do likewise appoint Matthew Wallace
 & William Wallace as the Executors of this my last will
 & Testament This 13th day of September A.D. 1794
