

Fifthly I will & allow the balance due on the above mentioned notes after paying off the two above mentioned legacies together with about forty dollars due me from Thomas Henry be applied to the payment of my debts & if there should be any surplus money after the payment of my debts as aforesaid I will & allow it to be paid to my Daughter again to do by my Executor hereafter to be named—

Lastly I do hereby Ordain, Appoint & constitute my trusty Friend William H. Green Esq. my whole & sole Executor of this my last will & Testament, hereby revoking and disannulling all former & other wills making & appointing this & this only as my last will & Testament—
Given under my hand & seal This 27th day of Aug^r 1819

In the name of God Amen, This day of January in the 4th year of our Lord 1819 I Samuel Wilson of the County of Northumberland in the State of N^c Carolina, being in perfect health & disposed to travel to a distant Climate knowing that it is appointed for all men to die—
Do make this my last will & Testament in the following manner— First of recommending my soul to God, my body to the Earth to be buried, And as touching my worldly Estate I give & devise as follows: It is my will & order that my just debts be paid, and after the payment of my debts, I give & bequeath to my daughter Dove the one half of my Estate to her for ever; I give & bequeath to my sister son David Waugh and my

Brother Winslow's son Hugh Lawrence the remainder of my Estate to be equally divided between them, excepting five shillings to each of my two brothers Benjamin and Lamson. I give & bequeath to my brother Winslow all my ~~existing~~ ^{existing} ~~property~~ ^{property}. It is my will & I declare that no person may discharge my father's for and debts due to me during his lifetime. Lastly I name, Nominate, Constitute & appoint my brother Winslow Executor of this my last will & Testament, bearing rehearing all other wills by me heretofore made either by word or writing, Relieving & confirming this & no other to be my last will & Testament signed sealed pronounced & declared by Samuel Wilson as his last will & Testament in presence of
