One Dollars out of a Note of hand given by him to me —  
 I give & bequeath to my beloved son Samuel his other two  
 dollars out of a note of hand given to me by Andrew Laseth  
 I give & bequeath to my beloved son Andrew Laseth his  
 promissory note of seven pounds, four shillings Pennsylvania  
 currency given to me by himself — I give & bequeath  
 to my beloved son by law Abram Woodward and my  
 Daughter Isabella ten Dollars out of a note of hand given  
 by Andrew Laseth to me, and to help of my wearing  
 apparel and my bed & furniture — I give & bequeath

 I give & bequeath to my beloved Grand son Ezekiel Sixty  
 my Bible 1/2 in dollars — I give & bequeath to my beloved  
 Grand daughter Mary Laseth my spinning wheel —  
 I give & bequeath to my beloved Grand Daughter Mary Venia  
 Laseth my saddle — I give & bequeath to my beloved

Likewise I do constate & appoint my beloved son James  
 Laseth & my son by law Samuel Sixty as whom sedately  
 I confide my looks & sole Executors of this my last Will &

 me made, and I do acknowledge this to be my last Will
