

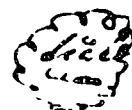

Mecklenburg & State of N. Carolina being weak of body, but of
perfect mind & memory, thanks be given to God, calling to mind the
mortality of the body and that it is appointed for all to die

in a Christian manner — And as touching my worldly estate
with it hath pleased God to bless me with I give & bequeath of
the following manner viz. — I give & bequeath to my beloved

son James Carothers Twelve Dollars & one half to be paid out
my Personal Estate to him & his heirs forever — I give & bequeath

Stott two Dollars to be paid out of my Estate and one half
my wearing Apparel — I give & bequeath to my beloved son
John Carothers Twelve dollars & one half to be paid out
my personal estate to him & his heirs forever — I give & bequeath
to my beloved son William Carothers three dollars to be paid
out of my personal estate to him & his heirs forever
I give & bequeath to my beloved son Andrew Carothers

Ten Dollars out of a note of hand given by him to me -
 I give & bequeath to my beloved son Samuel Carothers ten
 dollars out of a note of hand given to me by Andrew Carothers
 I give & bequeath to my beloved son Archibald Carothers
 promisory note of seven pounds, four shillings & sixpence
 currency given to me by himself - I give & bequeath
 to my beloved son by law Abraham Woodward and my
 Daughter Isabella ten Dollars out of a note of hand given
 by Andrew Carothers to me, and the help of my wearing
 apparel and my bed & furniture - I give & bequeath
 to my beloved son by law Samuel Neely one English Crown
 I give & bequeath to my two beloved Grand sons John &
 Samuel Neely ten dollars out of a note of hand given
 to me by Andrew Carothers to be equally divided between them
 I give & bequeath to my beloved Grand son Ezekiel Neely
 my Bible & five dollars - I give & bequeath to my beloved
 Grand daughter Mary Carothers my spinning wheel -
 I give & bequeath to my beloved Grand Daughter Mary Vane
 Carothers my saddle - I give & bequeath to my beloved
 Grand son James Carothers my hat -
 Likewise I do constitute & appoint my beloved son James
 Carothers & my son by law Samuel Neely or whom fidelity
 I confide my whole & sole Executors of this my last will &
 Testament. Likewise I do revoke all others & annul all
 former wills Legacies & bequests, whatsoever formerly by
 me made, and I do acknowledge this to be my last will
 & Testament. Given under my hand & seal this 2^d day of
 April 1798. - Signed sealed & acknowledged
