this my last will & Testament be witness whereof I the
said Henry Hargott Junr have hereunto set my hand & seal this
28th day of March 1803.

"In the name of God amen. I Sarah Harper of Middlebury County
being in a sick & low condition but of sound & perfect mind
& memory blessed be God, Do make & publish this my last will
& Testament in manner following. That is to say -
First I give & bequeath to my beloved Daughter Mary Brown
during her natural life eight negroes. Viz Lucy, Frank
Frederick, Anna, Charly, Hager, Sylvia & Prudy and all the household
furniture which includes all the beds & bedding, Tables, Disk, Linen
- board etc all which are or now in her possession. Also one Bay
Horse also the right to occupy myself & enjoy all the rights & privileges
in or into one certain tract of about 900 acres of land that I bought
of Adam Brown all the above legacy she is to possess during her
natural life & then to descend to her children as hereafter directed
Item. I give & bequeath to my beloved Grand daughter Sarah Harper
Daughter one negro Woman named Bicker one negro Girl named
Peg, one negro boy named Sandy & one negro boy named Moses to
gather with them increase or issue from this time henceforth writing
and other things now in her possession such as wheels &c to her &
her Heirs forever. Item. I give & bequeath to my beloved
grandson John Brown one certain tract of land containing

Nearly or about 200 acres which I purchased from Adam Brown
at being the said land that the said Adam Brown possessed before in
which said tract of Land I have by will given & set over to
the said John Brown to him & his assigns forever subject to
Nevertheless to the above circumstance of his mother's right of Dower
is it to the same closing her natural life if she doth so to keep it
also I give & bequeath to the said John Brown one Negro boy
named George and one Negro girl named Charlotte to him & his heirs
and assigns, never to gather with them again.

"Item. I give & bequeath to my beloved Grandson Frederic Hendon
Brown and one Negro boy named Frank, one Negro girl named Anna
together with their increase from the date hereof subject to the
right of Dower in his mother during her life as above to him
& his Heirs forever -

"Item. I give & bequeath to my beloved grand daughter Dorothy aka
Lelia Brown and one Negro girl named Adele three pieces from the just
time subject to the right of Dower in her Mother during life as above
my riding Saddle to her & his Heirs forever.

"Item. I give & bequeath to my beloved grand daughter Lucy Mowat
Brown and one Negro girl named Lydia three pieces from this date
subject to her mothers right of Dower closing life as above also
one bed & furniture on which to lie to her & his Heirs forever -

"Item. I give & bequeath unto my beloved grandson Jefferson
Brown and one Negro man named Frederick & one Negro
girl named Peedy three pieces from this Date, subject to his Mother
right of Dower during life as above to him his Heirs & assigns forever

"Item I give & bequeath to my beloved grand son Wm. Alexander
Gandy one Negro boy named Mark to him his to him the Wms
and assigns forever to be delivered to him or his legal guardian
at my Decades or as soon after his time may expire provided
nevertheless that in case the said William Alexander Gandy dies
under the age of 21 leaving no legal Heir of his body, then & in
that case the said Negro boy Mark shall be vested in & be the
property of my Grandson John Matthews D. & given to him &
his Heirs & assigns forever -

"Item. This my will & pleasure that at the death of my said daughter

nevertheless to the above circumstance of his mother's right of Domus
in & to the same claiming her natural life of the deceased to comply w^t
also I give & bequeath to the said John Brown one Negro boy
named George and one Negro girl named Charlotte to him & his heirs
and assigns, forever to go together with these items.

"Item. I give & bequeath to my beloved grandson Jessie Hamden
Brown and one Negro boy named Frank, one Negro girl named Anna
subject to their increase from the date hereof, subject to the
right of Dower in his mother during her life as above to him
& his Heirs forever -

"Item. I give & bequeath to my beloved grand daughter Dorothy Cha-
rlie Brown and one Negro girl named Maggie & her issue from this date
subject to the right of Dower in her Mother during life as above to
my riding Saddle to her & his Heirs forever -

"Item. I give & bequeath to my beloved grand daughter Lucy Morel
Brown and one Negro girl named Lydia & her issue from this date
subject to her mother's right of Dower during life as above also
on bed & furniture on which she now lies to her & his Heirs forever -

"Item. I give & bequeath unto my beloved grandson Jefferson
Hornepatch Brown and one Negro man named Frederick & one Negro
girl named Peedy & their issue from this Item, subject to his Mother
right of Dower during life as above to him his Heirs & assigns forever -

"Item I give & bequeath to my beloved grandson Wm. Alexander
Cooley one Negro boy named March to him his & his Heirs
and assigns forever to be delivered to him or his legal guardian
at my Descent or as soon after his birth may appear provided
nevertheless that in case the said William Alexander Cooley dies
under the age of 21 leaving no legal Heir of his body, then & in
that case the said Negro boy March shall be vested in & be the
property of my Grandson John Matthews Devisees to him &
his Heirs & assigns forever -

"Item. It is my will & pleasure that at the death of my said daughter
Mary Brown that all my Estates not otherwise willed by me
Charles Hall the household furniture &c shall be sold & the sum
received thereof after all my just debts are paid shall be equally

divided amongst my said six grand children viz Sally, John, Lewis, Harry, Derry & Jefferson all children to my said daughter Mary Harpers & to those or their heirs or to the survivors of them their heirs for ever -

Lastly I hereby make & ordain my worthy friends John Dawsone & Tom. & John Brown Executors of this my last will & Testament In witness whereof I have said Sarah Harper have to this my last will & Testament set my hand & seal this 17th day of January 1804 signed & also published & declared by the said Sarah Harper the Testator as her last will & Testament in the presence of us who were present at the signing & sealing thereof

I recommend my soul to God who gave it & my body to the dust from whence it came. As to my worldly estate that I have been blessed with; I give & bequeath in the manner & form as here mentioned. Item I give to my beloved wife Elizabeth the third of my moveable property household furniture & stock to be divided by the judgment of men. Item I give to my beloved Daughter Mary Sissie her & her Heirs forever my tract of Land I now live on, for the only use of her during her natural life & then to her Heirs forever for their only use likewise my negroes Bosac his wife Bassy & Ike & Hel.

Item I give to my Grandson Hugh Henson one negro girl named Sunday for his only use. - All Bonds Notes after my funeral debts is paid & funeral charges is discharged, the third to my wife & the remainder to my daughter Mary Sissie. My wife Eliza is liable to have her living of my plantation during her widow hood. & similar to wait upon her till her grandson is of age. Likewise I appoint my trusty friend Willm. m Ferguson & Thomas Boyd to execute this my last will & Testament given under my hand & seal the 13th day of January in the year of our Lord 1805
