I notwithstanding my body is infirm, I consider my mind & memory
to be sound, I recommend my soul to God who gave it, & my
body to be buried in a Christian manner; And as touching
worldly affairs after all my just debts are paid, In the first
place I will & bequeath to my beloved sister Nancy one dollar
in money & all my wearing apparel, Then I will & bequeath to
my beloved niece Elizabeth Henry the service of my servant
Amy her life or during the life of said Elizabeth Henry & if
she dies or is sold Amy to be liberated according to the
laws of the State, provided the said Amy is well treated
but if it can be made appear that she is not well treated I
allow my Executor to take her the said Amy & liberate her or
put her in the hands of some person that will treat her well
Then I will & bequeath to my kind friend Sally Carson or her
heirs all the same persons all my cattle, sheep & hogs & all my
household furniture & the balance of a note that I have upon
William Huston. Then I will & bequeath to the said
Sarah Carson my servant phoebe by her paying out my just
debts & repaying my several expenses & otherwise my 15th then
I leave to Intire forty Dollars & my niece Sally Carson forty
dollars, but it is not specified above I do hereby authorize
& empower my Executor to be the sole judge of the Treatment
that the said Amy may receive in the possession of the said
Elizabeth Henry. I do now nominate & appoint Job
Cannon & David I Thistle other and other my heirs & assigns
of this my last will & Testament to sign my hand & seal the 15th
day of December 1815

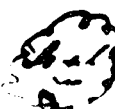

In the name of God Amen. I Rachel McKee of the County of Chesterburg State of Carolina, being in a low state of health but of sound mind & memory thanks to God for the same & willing to provide for the mortality of my body, knowing that it is appointed unto men once to die, I do make & bequeath this my last will & Testament in the manner & form following Vizth I commit my soul into the hands of God who gave it, & my body to be buried in a decent Christian like manner - pray all my debts -

2nd I give & bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Wilson my Negro woman Phoebe formerly given her with what time she has received from me herebefore, also Dick the third child of my Negro woman Betty I give & bequeath unto her - 3rd I give & bequeath unto my eldest son Samuel McKee my Negro man Simon with what time she I may have given unto him herebefore, also Polina the fifth child of my Negro woman Peggy I give & bequeath unto him & my margin with 4th I give & bequeath unto my son Joseph McKee my Negro woman Peggy with all her children (except Polina) namely Leje, Cynthia, Billy, Hanson & Margaret also one half of my body & time for nurture & what time formerly given I give & bequeath unto him -

5th I give & bequeath unto my son Stephen McKee the balance of my property namely Betty my old Negro woman Katey & all her children (except Dick) Viz Caroline, Eva line, Jack & Hannah also Sylvia & her child China; also half of my body & time for nurture & what time formerly given I give & bequeath unto him - and I hereby disannul all other wills by me herebefore made and do hereby constitute & appoint my three sons Samuel, Joseph & Stephen & my son in law John Wilson my Executors of this my last will & Testament. And have hereunto set my hand & seal this 5th September 1823.
