Do make & publish my last will & Testament in manner
& form following Principally & first of all I resign my
soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it in
hopes of his gracious acceptance And my body to the earth
to be buried in a decent Christian like manner at the
discretion of my children And as Touching my worldly
estate wherewith God hath blessed me with I dispose
of as follows —

In primis I Will & bequeath to my beloved daughter Sophia L Springs one book & furniture also to Mary Springs daughter Sophia L Springs a negro girl —
Secondly I Will & bequeath to my
beloved daughter Sarah A Harris one negro girl
named Julee in Trust for her daughter Eugenia G Harris
Thirdly I Will & bequeath to my beloved daughter Sophia L Roff
one negro woman named Esther Roff named Lydia like
her book & furniture, one side board, one long Table, one
big & heavy Table to Sophia L Roff daughter Sarah
Lynn Roff one negro boy named George —

Item: I Will & bequeath to Sarah Springs daughter of my
beloved son William P Springs dec'd one negro girl
named Betsy, also to Jane Leonora Springs daughter
of the aforesaid William P Springs one brown Heifer
and it is further my will & pleasure that the residue
and remainder of my estate both real & personal be
exposed to publick sale at a reasonable credit, and that
my executors pay all my just debts, and the remainder
if any there be distributed equally among my four
children To wit Adam A Spring, Mary Springs

Sarah & Maria, William Springs, and Sophia
 I do witnesseth that I have made this instrument
 and expect my family friends & near & dear to Joseph H.
 Bryan Executive of this my last will & Testament. hereby Rec
 voking all & every will I have before made; & in witness of the
 contents hereof I do hereby make & publish this my last will
 and Testament to testimony whereof I have hereunto
 set my hand & affixed my seal this Twelfth day of July
 A.D. 1839.

 disposing mind, do make & declare this my last Will &
 Testament and hereby revoke all paper writings, bonds
 instruments & papers purporting to be the same.

First. It is my will & desire that all my property real and
 personal be kept together under the control of George
 Smith my wife & my son William Franklin S.
 Smith for the common benefit of my family & the
 exceptions hereafter noted unless such time as my
 Executor or wife shall desire of my friends Samuel Wilson
 William Carson & William of Newbern in as the various
 thereof may think a Division be made there.

2. If the division aforesaid should take place during the
 life of my wife Eliza Smith it is my will & desire
 that she select either my house & lot in Town or my
 plantation known by the name of the Beauty tract which
 she is to hold & possess during her life in right of her
 Deed or —
