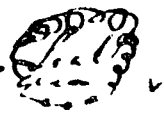


In the name of God Amen. I Susannah Emerson being in a

 effects to be sold or divided between them equally - Having given
 my Daughter Dicy Annard her share a ready house & allow
 me one Dollar - Lastly I order & appoint my son John Emerson
 Executor of this my last will & Testament. In Witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand & seal the 10th day of February,

 do make & declare this my last will & Testament, that is to say
 I give & recommend my Soul into the
 hands of Almighty God that gave it, and my body I recommend
 to the Earth to be buried in a decent Christian Burial at the
 discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the ge-
 neral resurrection I shall receive the same again by the
 mighty power of God. And as touching such worldly estate
 wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this life, I give
 & dispose of the same in the following manner & form -
 First of all my Debts to be paid - Item I give devise & bequeath
 to my loving son John Farrow the Land together with
 my line, only that I first order the
