Secd I leave to Brother Thomas K'Clare the blue suit of Clother that is
in a suit of Cl. that is in Pennsylvania also one Shirt Vane
hat on Brown Mare — Next I leave my Saddle & Bridle to
Mary & Clare a Child son to Thomas K'Clare —

The first thing to be done with the money is to pay me directly, now & I
pay all taxes but Fields there is Mr. Alexander Friend & there is nine
shillings to be paid to Robert Montgomery Esq in Pittsburg of Pennsylvania
The money that is due to me that I have no notes for payment here —

There is three pounds in Robert McNees hand \$38 in Alexander McWhirter
hand \$28.6 in Nathan Hakkens hand, there is something in
John Price hand, but how much I cannot tell he has paid me ten
pounds & when the house is measured it can't be told what is the
missing — And next I allow all the money to be divided into two
equal shares between John Boal & Thomas McElroy the gray mare
I allow to be sold & the price to be divided equally between the said

John Boal & Thomas McElroy — Preferring & confirming this & no other to be
my last will & Testament I witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand & seal — In case of my last happening I am obliged to set this after
the said & allow to be sold & equally divided between the said John

and declared by the said Thomas Boal as his last will & Testament
