leaving such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to blesse
me with in this life, I give direction & disposal of the same in the fol
lowing manner & form— First I give & command to my sonne
my beloued heire, first of all the lands with all their, meadows together
with all the household furnitures including all the geese, & it is my
will & desire that my wife before said shall & will give my sonne
beloued daughters Polly, Sally, Rachell & Haney Johnson that is
now in being & one more is clairly expected to be borne by my wife
divided if a female to share equally with the other four as they
are of age to each one a good proportionable land furnished
furthermore do allow my wife before said the full use of the
plantation her chaine of two of the work Horses six good cows
all the Sheep & all the, furnishing Utensils, one Sow & seven Hogs
eight Barrows of her own choosing & my negro fellow named
Pine clearing her wedewhood all this for the use & behoof of
reising & supporting the family—Despoying that death or
marriage should interrone with my wife before my two sond,
Thomas & Jones should come of age. I do allow this land
with all its appurtenances to the only sonne the heire of my before
mention'd two sonds Thomas & Jones Johnson; & despoyleyng the
above mentioned unborn shoud perte to be a male he shall
I will inheret an equal share with his above mentioned
brother; & supposing my wife shoud die in wedewhood
my before mentioned sond shall & will give my before mentioned
wife a comfortable sustinance during her life. It is also my
will that my wife shall have one large buche named after the
name, her natural life and at her death for to be retained under

living & supporting the family - supposing that death or
marriage should intervene with my wife before my two sons,
Thomas & James should come of age. I do allow the lands
with all its appurtenances to the only son & he of my before
mention'd two sons Thomas & James I command & suppose the
above mentioned unborn should prove to be a male he shall
have & inherit an equal share with his above mentioned
brother; & supposing my wife should survive in widowhood
my before mentioned son shall & will give my before mentioned
wife a comfortable sustenance during her life, it is also my
desire that my wife shall have an upright burial ground for the
burying her natural life, and at her death for so long related with
the other offspring to the us. behoof of my family. & according to that
my wife should die a widow & so by her present command
I command her to dispose or distribute as she sees cause all the
remainder of my goods chattels & effects to be paid to her and
