 dollars, also one saw & pigs that he claims — Then I will to my
 two daughters Margret Kennice & Jessent Kennice fifty dollars each
 Then I will & bequeath to my four sons viz. William Kennice and
Samuel Kennice & Robert Kennice & Joseph Kennice fifty dollars each
 all of which monies I will to raise from the sale of my property
 that is not willed & if any is wanting to make up said monies I
 will that it be made up out of the Cotton Crop; — Then I will
 that all the grain the wheat & the corn be kept for the use of
 the family & stock, I also will that one bush load & six bags that is
 nominatly viz. fine green barrows & one that is to be cut to be kept
 for the use of the family, I also will that the Grass shall be at the
 disposal of my loving wife & for the use of my family &c. —

This is my last will & Testament I acknowledge for witness
 whereof I have hereunto affixed my mark & said my last this
 18th day of July 1816



 probably on my death bed, declare the following to be my last
 will & Testament And first of all I commend my soul to God
 who gave it, and resign my body to the ground to be buried in
 a Christian Burial. Secondly all my Just Debts to be paid
 of my effects and the remainder to be disposed of in the following manner
 To my beloved wife Margret, I bequeath the Clock and the third
 of all the rest of my possessions now in my hands, my eldest

James has got all that I do allow him, also my second son John has got his part. To my daughter Susannah I bequeath twenty dollars more than she has got. My other two sons Robert & Hugh to be made equal as near as possible by an equal distribution of the dowry already given them. To my two youngest Daughters Mary Ann & Abigail I bequeath the remainders of my Effects to be equally divided between them with the exception of forty Dollars in favor of Mary Ann October 17th 1818

Joseph Kerr of the State of Carolina & County of Beaufort being in a weakly state of Body, but sound mind & memory calling to remembrance the mortality of my body & approaching dissolution of it; Do think it convenient to constitute this to be my last will & Testament; And first I recommend my soul into the hand of God, and my body to the earth to be decently interred therein at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same by the mighty power of God who gave it; and as to such Temporal property as it has pleased the Lord to bless me with, I dispose of it in the following manner & form — I give & bequeath to my well beloved wife Margaret Kerr the whole of every kind of worldly property that I possess during her natural life; and to be disposed of at her death as she may think proper — and I constitute and appoint and make my well beloved wife Margaret Kerr & my beloved son William Kerr to be the whole & sole Executors of this my last will & Testament.
