

Martinburg County North Carolina June 23<sup>d</sup> 1828

Be it however to all whom it may concern that I divide my plantation into three parts. To my son John I divide that part of my lands lying on the west side of the hollow below his field setting the creek a little above the back road to Joseph Evans home the other two divisions lying on the north and south sides of Cedar Creek running by my spring. That creek to be the dividing line ~~between~~ <sup>of</sup> three parts, ~~for~~ <sup>to</sup> my son to have choice of the last division the other to be equally divided in Selection between my daughter Elizabeth & my Grandson Thomas Green Bennett. To Elizabeth & hers should she have long I allow the half of the preceding part. The Smith Tools and Waggon I wish to be a common Stock for the use of all the members of my family all at the same time contributing their proportionable part of Labor or expense to repairing them when necessary, or perfect their right to the use of one or both my wife Jane I allow to hold my Mansion house during her life and then to have the disposal of the Household furniture.

I Thomas M'Coach of the County aforesaid in the full and perfect exercise of my mind, make & constitute this my last Will & Testament.

- 1<sup>st</sup> It is my Will that my funeral expenses and all my lawful Debts be punctually & faithfully discharged
- 2<sup>d</sup> It is my Will that my negro girl Abby be sold at public sale to discharge my debts, and if that is not

Sufficient it is my will that some other property be sold  
that the family comfort spare. & I will to my beloved  
wife Rebecca all of my Household furniture Kitchen  
furniture my Bay mare, my Stock of little Hogs  
farming Utensils also my plantation during her  
natural life so long as she shall provide the means  
on the plantation. Besides my children to the year  
of majority & my son as much shooting as  
is common for children in the country.

It is my will that my daughter Lucy be supported during  
her life from the proceeds of my farm, if my beloved wife  
should die or after her death, then it is my will  
that my remaining personal property be sold & equally  
divided between my children on my plantation also  
to be equally divided amongst them, but subject to  
the support of my daughter Lucy. It is my will  
that my executors sell my interest in the Seppion  
Gated Woods which is the one fourth of said mill  
which stands in my last will & testament  
as being hereby all former wills, gifts or bequests either  
by word or writing, Ratifying & confirming this and  
no other taking my last will & testament. In witness  
whereof I have signed and sealed the day & year  
above written - Sealed & sealed & delivered by the said  
Thomas McCord as his last will & testament, who in  
his presence has signed & sealed each. This been sub-  
scribed and witnessed
