 last will & testament, in manner & form following: I first of
 all recommend my Soul to God that gave it & my body to the grave unto

a decent burial in hopes of a happy resurrection this our Lord
& Saviour Jesus Christ & to my worldly effects I give bequeath and
distribute in the following manner - First I give & bequeath to my
beloved wife Eleanor Parker sixty pounds proclamation money of
V^t Carolina in eighteen months after my decease & likewise a good
batter bed & furniture immediately after my departure - Then I give
& bequeath to my eldest son Isaac Parker fifty & two pound pro-
clamation money of V^t Carolina in 18 months after my decease & likewise
a black horse six years old with a steer in his pen & a Rifle gun
plus some tools & trappings immediately after my Exit, Then I give &
bequeath to my son Isaac Parker fifty & two pounds proclamation
money of V^t Carolina in 18 months after my departure & likewise
one cow more three years old immediately after my Exit & likewise
some tools & trappings. Then I give & bequeath my Daughter Hannah
Parker fifty pounds proclamation money of V^t Carolina in eighteen
months after my departure, from this would I likewise a good bed and
furniture & a horse saddle & bridle the horse of Ten pounds price or Ten
pounds instead of said horse, I likewise do will & order my executor
to sell in the best advantage all my Estate both real & personal in order
to discharge all just debts funeral charges & all the Legacies or Legates
as also mentioned & the remainder of any of my Estate both real &
personal to be equally divided between my two sons above mentioned
which I do so appoint because I have no other my well beloved &
beloved friends Eleanor Parker my beloved wife & Isaac Parker my
son executors of this my last Will & Testament. Nothing and
disannulling all former Wills & Testaments that I have made &
publicly declare & hereby profess this to be my last Will & Testament
& the true intent & meaning thereof be whereof I have hereunto set
my hand & fixed my seal this 4th day of July 1767.
