my daughter Hannah fifty pounds proclamation money of N^o Carolina
Eighteen months after my departure from this World & likewise a good
further bed & furniture & a horse saddle & bridle the horse of Ten
pound price, a ten pounds instead of said horse; I likewise do Will
& Order my Executors to sell to the best Advantage all my estate
both real & personal in order to discharge all just debts & sum
charges & all the Legacies or Legatees above mentioned & the remain
der if any of my Estate both real & personal to be equally divid
between my two Sons above mentioned. And I do also

my son to be the sole Executors of this my last Will & Testam
ent hereby & disavowing all former Wills & Testaments that I
