lamation money of N^o Carolina in eighteen months after my departure
likewise on Deer Man three years old immediately after my
death & likewise plow Irons & Tools - I give & bequeath
my daughter Hannah fifty pounds proclamation money of N^o Carolina
Eighteen months after my departure from this World & likewise a good
further bed & furniture & a horse saddle & bridle the horse of ten
pound price, a ten pounds instead of said horse; I likewise do Will
& bequeath my Executors to sell to the best Advantage all my estate
both real & personal in order to discharge all just debts & sum
charges & all the Legacies or Legatees above mentioned & the remain
der if any of my Estate both real & personal to be equally divid
between my three sons above mentioned. - I do also like
my last will & Testament in my last beloved wife & my
friend Leazer Parker my beloved wife & Isaac Parker my
son to be the sole Executors of this my last will & Testam
ent touching & discharging all former Wills & Testaments that I
have made, & to publicly declare & sign in my life this to be my
last will & Testament & the true intent & meaning thereof in
witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 4th
