buried in a Christian like & decent manner at the direction
of my executors, as touching such worldly goods as he has pleased
God to bless me with in this life. I give & bequeath to the
following manner. First let all my lawful debts be paid -
Imprimis To my well beloved Cousins Robert & Thomas Patton
each one of them their choice one one more & let each one
paying three pounds - Then To my Cousins Sillye and
Mary & Elizabeth Patton to each one Dollar - Then to my
well beloved Aunt Sillye Williams one two year old
black mare - Then And the remainder of my estate The sum
of 100 my well beloved Brother William Patton &
the other third to my beloved Mother Elizabeth Patton
James Patton I constitute & appoint to be my sole executor
of this my last will & Testament - Given under my hand &
seal the day & year above written
