 That it is appointed for all men once to die, Do make & order This my last will
 & Testaments, and first & principally of all I give my soul into the hands of Al-
 mighty who gave it & my body to the earth to be buried in a decent and
 Christian like manner at the discretion of my executors, And touching
 such worldly goods as it has pleased God to bless me with in this life
 I give & bequeath in the following manner and form
 First I bequeath all my just debts & funeral charges to be paid -
 2^d I give & bequeath to my Children Joseph, Davina, & G Smith each one
 a bed & furniture; and likewise Davina & G Smith each the horse
 that they name either Davina or Corn & calf. -
 3^d I give & bequeath to my Children Robert, Mary, Thomas, Agnes
 Samu'el, Richard & James one dollar each as their full share of my Estate
 4th I give & bequeath to my Children Joseph & G Smith the plantation
 to be equally divided between them. Each of them paying twenty five
 dollars Thereover to my son Egebral the other to my son John - - -
 5th I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Polly one bed & furniture one
 horse & saddle, two cows & calves, the other property to pay the debts -
 I likewise appoint my wife Polly & my son Joseph the exe-
 cutors of this my last will & Testament, And I hereby disavow
 & make void all former wills & testaments this & this only my last will
 & Testament Signed & sealed the 15th day of July 1828
