& constitute my son John Wilson my sole executor
of this my last will & Testament. In witness whereof
I hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 15th day
of June in the Year of our Lord 1815

In the Name of God Amen. I Thomas heir of the
County of Mchland by & State of N^c Carolina, being
in a weakly State of health but of sound mind &
men my thanks be to God Therefore, calling to
mind the mortality of my body knowing that it is
appointed for all men once to die, Do make & ordain
this my last Will & Testament, That it is to say principally
& first of all I give my soul into the hand of Almighty
God That gave it, and my body I recommend to the dust
to be buried in a decent manner at the discretion
of my Executors, and as touching such worldly estate
wherein with it hath pleased God to bless me within
this life I give & dispose of the same in the following
manner & form viz I give & bequeath unto Margaret
heir my dearly beloved wife all that plantation
on which I now live for & during her life I also give
her one old black man, I also give her one red & white
cow & calf & one spotted sow & six pigs, I also

Give her one Feather bed & furniture, one Walnut Chest
& four Chairs & all Cupboard furniture & all the pots &
buns, pot hooks, Trimmings, Shanks & Tongs & all her dress
to be set by my Executors. Item I give & bequeath to
unto William Wier my beloved son one dollar

Item I give & bequeath unto Thomas Wier my beloved son one dollar

Item I give & bequeath unto Edward Wier my beloved son one dollar

Item I give & bequeath unto Mary Wier my beloved daughter

one feather bed & furniture, I also give her one Room & all
her Trappings & also her new saddle & also one black
three year old horse. Item I give & bequeath unto
unto the Galleyway my beloved daughter one dollar

Item I give & bequeath unto Betsy Wier my beloved daughter
one feather bed & furniture & also her wheel & saddle

Item I give & bequeath unto Margaret Gibbs my beloved
daughter one dollar, It is further my will & pleasure
that the Land willed to my wife Margaret and the
remainder of my Estate if any should be put to pub-
lic sale & after all my just debts & the Legacies are
paid the remainder shall be divided among my
three daughters viz Mary, Betsy & Margaret
It is my will & pleasure that Mary Wier gets thirty
dollars more than an equal share, & that Betsy gets
Twenty dollars more than an equal share, & that
Margaret gets the Remainder — And I do hereby
constitute & appoint Edward Wier my beloved
son & Nathan Wier son to Nathan Wier to be my sole
of this my last will & Testament, & so hereby revoke &
disannul all & every other former wills Testaments & Legacies
& bequests by me named willed & bequeathed, Or testifying
this & no other to be my last will & Testament, In
Witness whereof I the said Thomas Wier have
hereunto set my hand & seal this 4th day of May 1816

Be it by these presents remembered that Henry
 Walker of the County of Mecklenburg & State of North
 Carolina, well knowing the mortality of Life, Do
 think proper by these presents to will & direct that my
 property after my death shall be disposed of managed
 & conducted in the manner that I shall hereafter point
 out & by the person or persons that I shall appoint
 by this my last will & Testament as Executors of the
 same. In the first place my body is to be decently
 Interred Secondly all lawful debts to be paid Thirdly
 The land on which I live to be divided into three
 parcels or tracts, one of which contains 200 acres
 lying & being on the Creek to belong to my son John
 Jefferson, The second containing 100 acres & including
 the houses to belong to my widow during her lifetime
 after which time to be equally divided between
 my two sons, The balance of the land containing
 200 acres more or less to belong to my son James
 So much of my stock is to be sold as will be neces-
 sary to pay my debts, I wish a Horse Cows & Calf &
 good bed & furniture be given 1 each of my unmarried
 daughters (save Henry who has been provided for) —
 Upon Marriage or death of the widow unless which
 event, I will that the whole Family boys & girls
 should live with the widow who if she sees fit
