of my Executors. And as touching such worldly estate  
it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life I give  
& dispose of in the following manner & form. Viz -  
I give & bequeath to Margret Wilson my dearey beloved  
wife the House & plenishing also two Cows & calves Bell-  
bell calfe also three three Hogs home Eare. My son James  
is to mow my meadow, make my hay, & putt it up  
also cut my fire wood & haul it & some half an acre  
of flax. Also my sonch house is to be had also all  
Dowry left to her by her father Item I give & bequeath  
unto James Wilson my beloved son all that Dapage  
that a pece of Land on which I now dwelle  
Item I give & bequeath to my grand daughter Catherin  
one Cow & calfe, two Eares, a new lothe, two suits of  
Clothes, one of them bought the other home made, þas  
bed & bedding worth ten pounds also five pounds in  
money & six months Schadling of the stys with her  
grand mother till she is fifteen years of age. & if no  
she gets no Bed or bedding nor no money but one pair  
when she comes to the age of fifteen years . . . .  
And I do hereby constittute & appoint Margret Wilson  
my dearey beloved wife & James Wilson my son my Sol.  
Executors of this my last will & testament. & do here  
utterly disallow make & disowne all & every  
other former wills, testaments, legacies & Executors  
by me in any wise named, limited or bequeathed  
before Ratifying this & no other to be my last will  
& testament - In witness whereof I the said  
Thomas Wilson have hereund set my hand &

North Carolina Mecklenburg County Nov<sup>th</sup> 30<sup>th</sup> 1795  
I being of sound mind & memory do hereby to remembrance  
the mortaliy of my nature & the uncertainty of life -  
do think it convenient to constiute this my last will  
& Testament & by these presents to will & dispose of my  
temporal concerns in the following manner Viz  
I give & bequeath my body to the dust to be decently  
interred thereon at the discretion of my executors & my  
soul into the hands of God who gave it I give  
& bequeath to my well beloved wife Elizabeth Wilson  
all my household furniture her Spinning Wheel one  
black horse called black one brown mare called Gil one  
large & one small set of plow tools with the plow & team  
two pair of new Chains & their Tools. three cows of  
Calves one three year old three year old of Sheep, four  
of my best Barren hogs all the grain & forage belong-  
ing to the plantation, her riding saddle the above  
articles to be valued by persons appointed by my exec-  
& to be remeia the property of my wife Elizabeth  
during her widowhood & in case of her marriage then  
the one half of said valuation to be equally divided  
between my four children. such articles as are for  
immediate family consumption are not to be apprised  
or valued ~~then~~ I give & bequeath to my well beloved  
son Cyrus all that part of my lands & improvements which  
lie in South & South East of a line running from a live  
Oak tree above my Spring House to a Oak tree (now in  
mine & Richard Kerrs corner) Then I give & bequeath
