 of the County of Mecklenburg & State of North
 Carolina being in declining circumstances of
 life tho' of perfect mind & memory. Do make &
 declare this my last will & Testament & it is my
 desire that it be received by all as such. First
 I bequeath my Soul to God who gave it & my
 body to the Earth from whence it came to be
 buried in a Christian & decent manner with as
 little ceremony as may be, and as to my earthly Estate
 wherewith I have been blessed I dispose of in the
 following manner. I bequeath to my beloved
 wife Sarah the house I now live in & my negro
 girl Bet & to be maintained off my plantation
 during her natural life & at her decease my
 dwelling house to belong to my son Robert
 Dickerson at his decease my negro girl Bet
 to belong to my son William H. It is my will
 & pleasure that my plantation shall be equally

divided between my three sons Hugh Thomas & Robert exclusive of the part I have given my son William. It is also my will & pleasure that Hugh shall have my negro boy named Eli —

Item It is also my will & pleasure that my stock of every kind shall be equally divided between my three sons Hugh Thomas & Robert & James. It is also my will & pleasure that my household furniture be equally divided between Hugh Thomas & Robert. Except the bedding belonging to my daughter Ann which I allow her to have together with her horse & saddle & cow & calf & negro child named Mary & her spinning wheel.

Item I bequeath to my sons James & John & my daughter Elizabeth Morris four dollars each. Item It is my will & pleasure that if my negro woman has any further offspring the first shall belong to my son Thomas the second to Robert & the third to my son James's eldest son Thomas. And I do hereby appoint John Wilson & John Bain my executors of this my last will & Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 26th day of September 1817.
