Jane brought with her at our marriage shalbe adorne ditherself
Item I give & bequeath unto my belov'd son John the one negro
boy known by the name of Young Tom now in his sixtien. Then
I give & bequeath unto my belov'd son James one negro girl known
by the name of Elizabeth, Then I give & bequeath unto my belov'd
daughter Eliza both living at or near fort Charlotte one negro girl known
by the name of Prudence & I desire her to be left in possession of my
son Reuben & when the said negro girl comes to the age of somwhere
yeare old there shall be appraised by me & if my daughter Elizabeth
doth not come into summe of m^r Hoods, & not by herself, but thereby, the said
woman to the comes to the aforesaid Eliza then my son Reuben shall
have it to his choice whether to give the woman, & pay the apprais-
ment. Then I give & bequeath unto my belov'd Daughter Rach
Maffey one negro girl known by the name of Young Agnes. Then
I give & bequeath unto my belov'd Daughter Phoebe Harrison
one negro girl known by the name of Young Dinah. Then I
give & bequeath unto my Daughter Lydia a fifty one negro
girl known by the name of Hannah. Then I give & bequeath unto

made & ordain this my last will & testament, And first of all I give my soul unto the hands of the Almighty God that gave it, & my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in a decent manner at the discretion of my executors, And as touching my worldly estate wherein it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life I give & devise uppon same in the following manner & form as follows; First I desire that all my lawful debts be paid out of one hundred & forty pounds & I do not make use of in my life time. — I give & bequeath to my dear beloved son David Johnson, George, Solomon & Nathan to be equally divided amongst them, Item I give & bequeath unto Jane Head my beloved wife one hundred pounds & two shillings less of my stock & twenty bushels of biscuit in addition to her weekly basket of bread. — Item it is my desire & pleasure that all the furniture that my wife Jane brought with her at our marriage should be at her disposal Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved son John one negro boy known by the name of Young Tom now in his fifteenth year Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved son James one negro girl known by the name of Charlotte, Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved daughter Eliza both living at a neareast plantation one negro girl known by the name of Providence & desire her to be left in the possession of my son Nathan & when the said negro girl comes to the age of fourteen years old then has she to be apprised by me if my Daughter Elizabeth doth not come into none of my heirs, and by lawfull inheritance, for such would to the come to the aforesaid Negro then my son Nathan shall have it to his choice whether to give the woman, or pay the appraisement. Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Ruth Pafford one negro girl known by the name of Young Agnes, Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Phoebe Harrison one negro girl known by the name of Young Dick. Item I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Ida (if I live) one negro girl known by the name of Hannah. Item I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Eliza (if I live) one negro girl known by the name of Sarah. Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved Son Jacob one negro boy called Joseph & also all the plantations & slaves do him with all privilege or improvement hee

sover belong to the said Hart of Land to him & his Heirs & assigns
now, and also my waggon & gears & to him also all my plantations
tools of every kind & also it is my will & pleasure that my three
 negroes known by the name of old Isaac & old Hagen & old Andy
shall be sold among my legatees & the money to be equally divided
among my wife Jane & my four Daughters vizt. Lydia
Phoebe & Mary, & further it is my will & pleasure that all the
remainder of my moveable property that is not before mentioned
horses, Cows, Sheep & Hogs & household furniture to be appraised and
equally divided between my wife Jane & my four daughters vizt.
Rachel, Phoebe, Lydia & Mary. And I do hereby constitute &
appoint my Son Rebecca & Capt James Hobson to be my sole Ex-
ecutors of this my last will & Testament, Desirous nothing all &
every other former wills Testaments & Legacies by me named written
& signed either before, Be it witness & confirming this & no other to be
my last will & Testament; In witness whereof I the said James
Hobson have hereunto set his hand & affixed his seal this 12th day
of April 1797.
